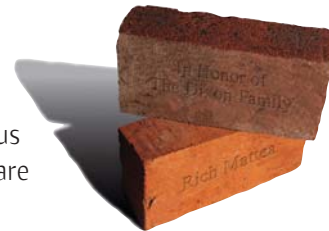

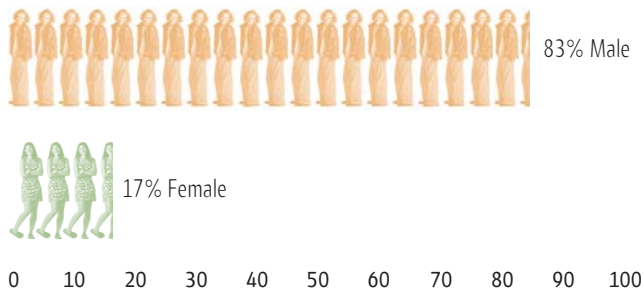

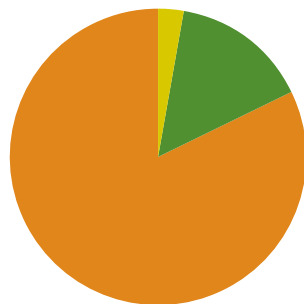

Age at intake

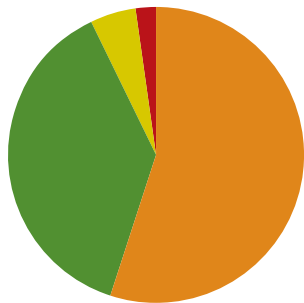
