The wise man said, *Death and life are in the power of the tongue* (Proverbs 18:21a). That truth is both a caution and an encouragement about how I should speak to my family.

When I fail and say things I shouldn't I need to humbly seek forgiveness and be willing to forgive when words have hurt me. HOW ABOUT YOU?

Fire isn't all bad. If controlled, it can help in the same as words of encouragement, support, and love can help.
