Sharing Cur Faith

Why are we involved in the weekly FAMILY MEMORY PASSAGE? One big reason is found in John 15:7.

John 15:7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

In order for the words of the Lord really to abide in us, it seems clear that we should commit as many of them to memory— not only in our minds but in our hearts—as we possibly can. "Thy word have I hid in mine heart that I might not sin against thee" (Psalm 119:11).

There are many promises of blessings to those who have God's Word in their hearts. "For it is a pleasant thing if thou keep them within you; Let them all be fixed upon your lips" (<u>Proverbs 22:18</u>). "My son, if you receive my words, And treasure my commands within you;...Then you will understand the fear of the Lord, And find the knowledge of God." (<u>Proverbs 2:1</u>, 5).

Both the apostle Paul and the apostle Peter have noted the importance of Scripture memorization. Paul says: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord" (Colossians 3:16).

Peter's exhortation is as follows: "Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder), that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior" (2 Peter 3:1-2). The words "be mindful" mean essentially "recall to mind."

Since the Scriptures cannot be recalled to mind unless they've first been installed in the mind, and since they cannot abide in our hearts unless we first hide them in our hearts, it is surely pleasing and honoring to God that we learn "by heart" as much of His Word as we can.

Thus, the need for the FAMILY MEMORY PASSAGES!
