



History

The building in which the apartment sits was first commissioned in 1921 by Wolseley motors and designed by architect William Curtis Green drawing on Venetian and Florentine influences. The ground floor of this Grade II listed building is now home to The Wolseley, a café restaurant in a grand European style which has been in occupation since 2003.
