A beautifully presented, spacious apartment arranged over two floors with high ceilings throughout. The property has a large reception room with open plan kitchen leading out to a private terrace.

There is an additional reception room to the front of the property with large sash windows and an open fireplace. On the lower floor are three double bedrooms all with generous built-in wardrobes and en suite bathrooms. The main bedroom also benefits from a private patio.

Green Street has built up since the mid-18th Century, but most of the current properties date from the late 19th and early 20th Century.

The building has had a number of significant residents including various members of the British aristocracy, the James Bond author Ian Fleming and also The Beatles. Green Street is built to the designs of Sir Robert W. Edis in 1891–4, and are characterised by shaped gables, deep porches and a lavish use of terracotta ornament.

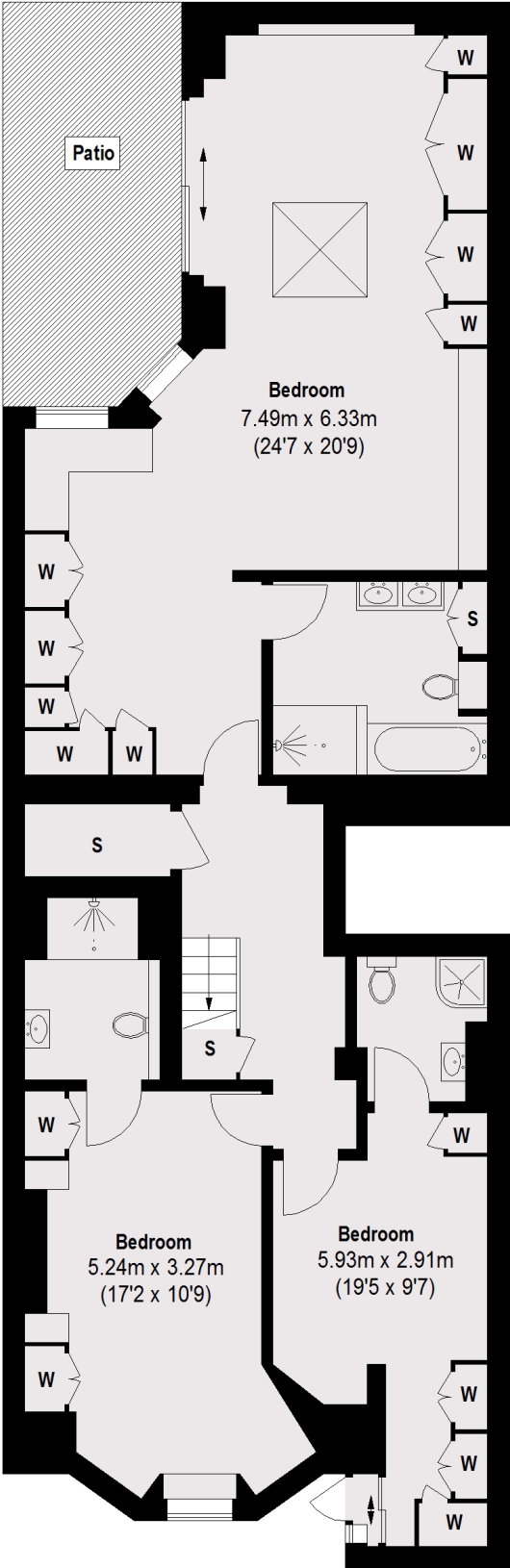

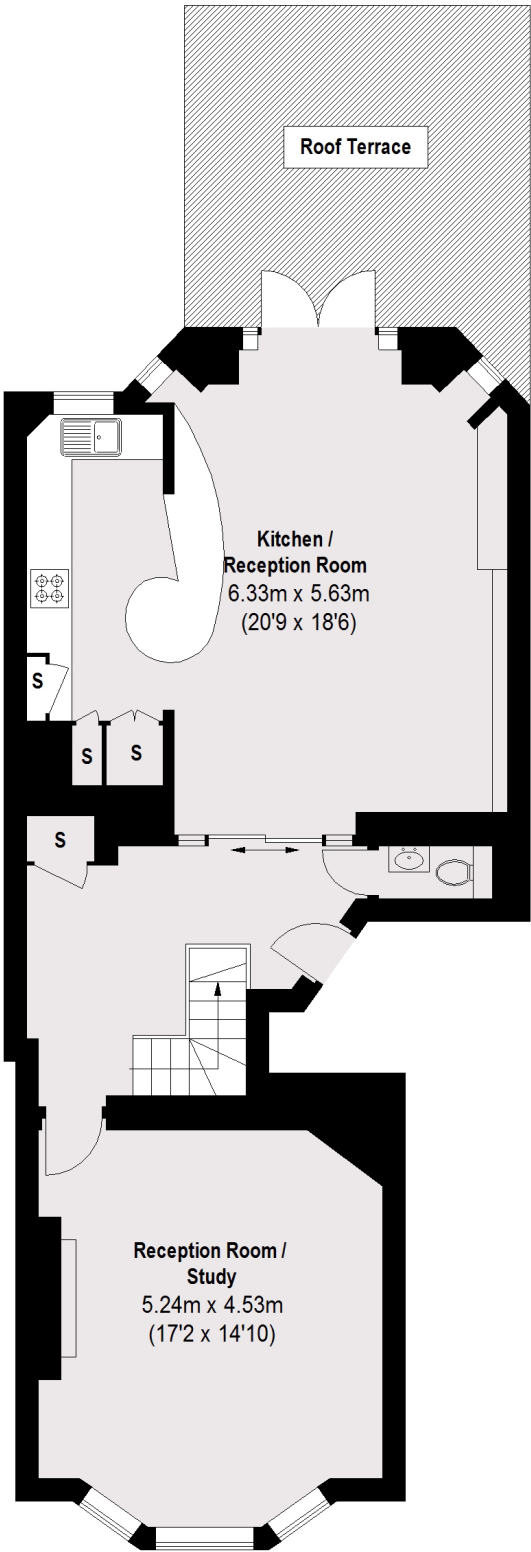
