A beautifully presented, spacious apartment arranged over the first and second floors of this period building. On the first floor, there is a large reception room to the front with balcony overlooking Green Street and an eat-in kitchen at the rear. The second floor has three double bedrooms all with built-in wardrobes, two en suite bathrooms and one separate bathroom. The apartment also benefits from a store room of circa 20 sq. ft.

Green Street has been built up since the mid-18th Century, but most of the current properties date from the late 19th and early 20th Centuries. The building has had a number of significant residents including various members of the British aristocracy, James Bond author Ian Fleming, as well as The Beatles. Green Street was built to the designs of Sir Robert W. Edis in 1891–4, and is characterised by shaped gables, deep porches and a lavish use of terracotta ornament.
