## Auburn Businesses are OPEN to EVERYBODY

Over the past several months, a handful of attorneys from outside the Auburn/Opelika area, claiming to represent disabled clients, have targeted local businesses and threatened federal lawsuits for noncompliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The notification letters to the businesses not only threatened litigation, but also required the businesses to pay a settlement fee to the attorney. In an effort to assist and support our members, the Auburn Chamber recently hosted two informational meetings to clear confusion and, hopefully, reduce unnecessary lawsuits.

The first meeting was held to hear feedback from business owners and assess the situation. Local and state officials also attended the meeting with the goal of gathering information. Once the scope of the problem was clear, the board quickly communicated the growing concern to our federal delegation on behalf of our members.

The second meeting held at the chamber was an "all call" to our members—and not-yet members—to join the board and staff for a presentation from Dennis Miles, a well-known ADA design specialist. Two local attorneys also joined the panel to offer legal guidance. Moderated by our past chair, Alex Muncie, and current chairman of the board, Joe Donaldson, the thorough and informative meeting offered our members the chance to better understand the complexities of the ADA statute. It was obvious from the dialogue that the most important issue for each business was to do what was needed to bring their place of business into compliance. No business who received a complaint letter had the intent of denying access to any patron.

Business owners in attendance shared initial estimates for the work necessary to bring their businesses into compliance. Figures ranged from \$1,000 to \$50,000. There is no doubt this expense was not in the small business owners' current budgets, nor was the \$5,000 settlement fee being charged by the attorneys on behalf of their clients. While most businesses are eager to correct any problems, this unfortunate threat of federal lawsuits and settlement fees creates animosity and leaves the small business owners with suspicion and mistrust. The ADA was designed to give the disabled full access to businesses, but a handful of attorneys have made the regulations a tool for their own unethical practices.

Every Auburn business member should have received an email from us this week requesting data to be shared with our legislators. Our aim is not to change the law, but rather to make compliance simpler and less cost prohibitive. If your business has been affected, please respond so that we can bring a collective message to our state and federal officials.

The business owners and citizens of Auburn both deserve respect and understanding as we work through this situation together.

### EAMC RECOGNIZED—FOR 7TH STRAIGHT YEAR—AS TOP 10% IN NATION FOR ORTHOPEDIC SURGERY EXCELLENCE BY HEALTHGRADES
