All Cremation is NOT the same. Every cremation choice that we offer falls under the strict guidelines of Cremation Done Properly - THE Gold Standard in cremation care.

The Cremation Done Properly™ 10 Step Turn-Key Process:

Your loved one NEVER leaves the care of our team at ANY Time.

1. Confirmation of Identity at The Place of Death:

A personal identification band is placed on your loved one as soon as their identity is confirmed by a member of our team.

2. Positive ID by next of Kin:

Your loved one will be bathed and/or disinfected and then dressed in the clothes that the family provides or a dignified gown that we provide. They will then be placed in the cremation casket that you have selected and taken to a viewing room, where the identification will take place, in a proper setting.



3. Thumbprinting: A thumbprint will be made of your loved one while in our care. This print will be kept on file perpetually so there is a lasting, permanent record of your loved one's identity.

4. Individual Assignment: One of Our Funeral Home Team Members is assigned to your loved one & accom-

panies and supervises the ENTIRE cremation process.

5. Final Failsafe: After Positive Identification by the Next of Kin has taken place Three individuals- A certified cremation specialist, A Funeral Director, and the funeral home team member assigned to your loved one will review all cremation paperwork and permits. Your loved one's

identification band will again be cross-checked against the paperwork as a final failsafe before cremation.

6. Scheduling a specific Time for the cremation: Unlike most, we schedule a specific appointment time with the Crematory so that they are ready to receive us, in order for the cremation to begin on time & proceed smoothly. We do not just show up & drop off your loved one, then leave as soon as possible & HOPE things turn out OK.

7. Showing proper respect: Your loved one is transported from the funeral home to the crematory in our own hearse – **NOT a cargo van. NOT a casket delivery truck.**

8. Ability To Witness: We allow the next of kin to accompany our team member & witness

their loved one being placed in the crematory. That way, there is no doubt about the cremation facilities & procedure. We do not charge extra for witnessing.

9. Prompt Return: Once the cremation process is complete, the team member assigned to your loved one will immediately bring the cremated remains back to the funeral home, where they are logged in & placed in a secure area.

10. Appropriate Reuniting: After the cremated remains are returned to the funeral home, we will contact you to set up a time for receipt of the cremated remains. At this time, we will provide a proper setting in which to receive the Urn, where you may wish to spend a few moments in quiet remembrance.
