- Canceling utilities: cell phones, cable, Internet etc....

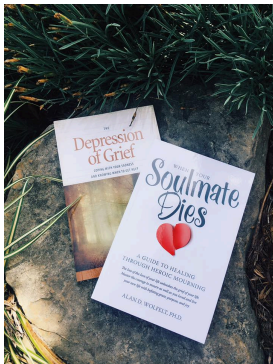
