There are plans to have a big celebration service in the sanctuary on Christmas Day! The pouring of the slab which will be the roof of the sanctuary and the floor of the proposed Medical clinic, which will be located on the level above the sanctuary, should be completed a few days before Christmas. The official day to begin using the new sanctuary full-time will be Sunday, January 20th (while the team is there). Although the building will not be complete as the doors, windows, electrical, plumbing, and plastering of walls will still need to be purchased and installed, the building will be completely functional and much larger than the 40’ x 60’ tent that they have used since April 2015.
