HOW TO FRINGE

Your Unique Fringe Experience

There's really only one thing you should know before you embark on your Fringe journey — every Fringe experience is unique. And in the first year of our fest, you'll have every opportunity to choose your own adventure.

176 projects from a variety of disciplines have registered for the Fringe. More than 800 performances are scheduled over 11 days. There are more than 30 venues, from large, multi-theater performance spaces to city parks, bars and beauty salons.

Fringe is a constantly evolving phenomenon, a collective creativity which holds a mirror to our modern society. Your experiences, preferences and interactions during this festival can influence that reflection. So start here, and let your imagination (and the imaginations of others) take you on a freaky, fun-filled journey.

Where to Start

Fringe Central is a great place to start if you're not sure what to do. The Visibility Stages on the Egyptian Theatre Courtyard will feature previews of a variety of Fringe shows, and you can purchase tickets at the Fringe Central Box Office. Use this Guide to help you find shows that interest you. And don't be afraid to take risks!

Buying Tickets

Tickets are available at hollywoodfringe.org or by calling 866-811-4111. During the festival, you can stop by the Fringe Central Box Office (1625 N. Las Palmas) to purchase tickets to any Fringe show. Tickets will also be sold at the door of most performances.

Opening & Closing Night Events

Check out the Opening Night Party on Wednesday, June 16th, as well as the Closing Night Party on Sunday, June 27. There also will be an Awards Ceremony at Fringe Central on Sunday, June 27. More details are online at hollywoodfringe.org.

Talk About It

Talking about your Fringe experience is one of the most valuable contributions you can make. Giving feedback to an artist about their work or suggesting a show you loved to a friend are powerful medicine for the arts. Write reviews for Fringe shows at www.hollywoodfringe.org, or update your own blog, twitter, or facebook account with your unique point of view. GETTING AROUND

The Hollywood Fringe Festival highlights some of Los Angeles' best qualities — creative environments, diverse communities and opportunities for success. Los Angeles has some other well-known attributes we hope not to exacerbate, including traffic, urban sprawl and some of the worst air quality in the country. A lot of people drive in Los Angeles, but it's easy to use public transportation, and we encourage you to do just that!

Public Transportation

Los Angeles has the Metro, an extensive public transportation system which includes buses and rail lines. The Hollywood/Vine and Hollywood/Highland stops on the Red Line are within walking distance to all Fringe venues. You can plan your public transportation trip at www.metro.net.

Many of the railway stops also have parking lots where you can leave your car and then head into Hollywood. If you're coming from the North, we highly recommend parking at the North Hollywood or Universal City lots (free) and heading in on the Red Line.

Parking in Hollywood

If you have to bring your car, there are a few things you'll need to consider. Parking in Hollywood can be difficult most evenings and weekends, so make sure to plan for extra time. There's very little free parking within the Fringe boundaries, and many of these spaces are reserved for local residents. Always make sure to read the posted signs!

There are dozens of parking lots in Hollywood, most with a flat rate of \$8-15. One of the best rates is at the Hollywood & Highland Center lot (with entrances on Orange Dr. and Highland Ave.), which charges \$2 for the first four hours (with validation), or a daily maximum of \$10. There are also two parking structures directly adjacent to Fringe Central (1625 N. Las Palmas) which charge a flat rate.

Walking & Biking

Most of the venues are within walking distance of each other, so it's possible to conveniently see four or five shows in a relatively short period of time. Depending on how much traveling you are willing and able to do during the festival, you can use this Guide to plan how you want to spend your day at the Fringe.

THE ART OF THE FRINGE

Around three years ago, when we were first coming up with visual ideas for The Hollywood Fringe Festival, one of the concepts I kept coming back to was a hand-made look. I wanted to emphasize roughness, honesty and dedication to craft. When it came time to design the guide cover for the first festival, I wanted to come back to the hand-made idea. I came up with an idea for what is basically a photographed diorama -- the freaks are made out of clay in front of a paper Hollywood skyline and hills, with a flock of over 100 hand-cut birds flying in the sky above. 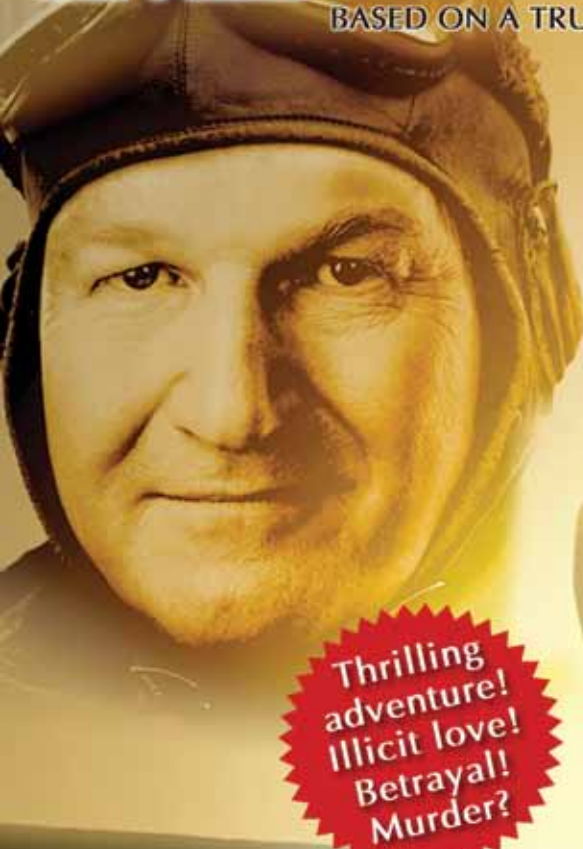

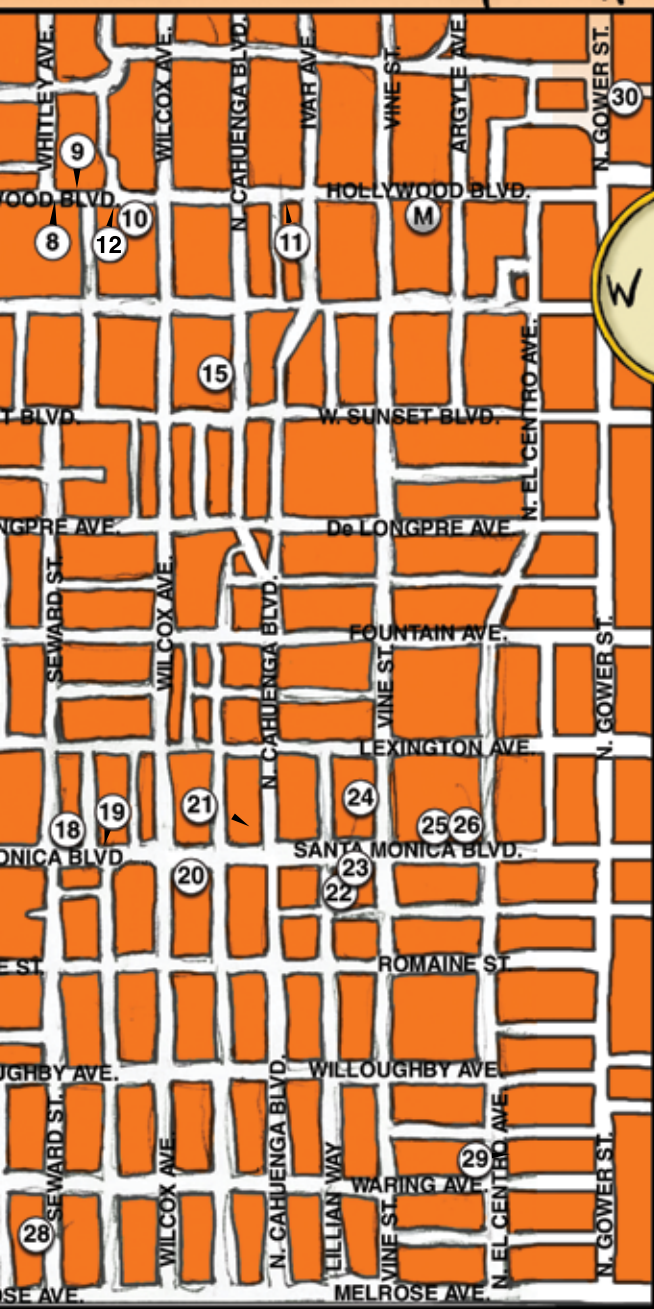
