- 1 - 4mm Emerald Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Bead (04RD0116)
- 1 - 4mm Peridot AB Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Bead (04RD0114)
- 1 - 4mm Fuchsia Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Bead (04RD0108)
- 1 - 4mm Amethyst Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Bead (04RD0127)
- 1 - Thai Hill Tribe Silver Puffed Heart Charm (TH6328)
- 1 - Thai Hill Tribe Silver Leaf Charm (TH6333)
- 1 - Thai Hill Tribe Silver Round Hammered Toggle Clasp (TH6387)
- 6 - 5mm Sterling Silver 19 Gauge Jump Rings (SS3948)
- 1 - 8mm Sterling Silver 19 Gauge Jump Ring (SS3958)
- 2 - Thai Hill Tribe Silver 20 Gauge 1/14 inch Flower Head Pin (TH6295)
- 2 - 22 gauge Sterling Silver 1 inch Head Pins (SS4697)
- 2 - 10.5x10.1mm Sterling Silver Large Ribbon Ends (SS4417)
- 5 inches - 2mm Apple Satin Cord (SM4736)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Simple Loop

Instructions to complete “Flower Garden” bracelet:

Step 1

Using scissors, cut a 5-inch length from each of the three cords.

Step 2

Holding the ends of the three lengths of cord side by side with the apple green cord in the middle, place the ends between the jaws of one ribbon end. Using chain nose pliers, gently squeeze the jaws together. Tug the cords to check that they are secure; if not, squeeze the jaws a bit more tightly.

Step 3

Repeat Step 2 on the other end of the cords with the second ribbon end.

Step 4

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and use it to attach a second 5mm jump ring to the loop on one ribbon end. Close the jump ring.

Step 5

Open the second jump ring from Step 4, and attach it to the bar side of the toggle clasp. Close the jump ring.

Step 6

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to connect the loop on the other ribbon end to the 8mm jump ring. Close the jump ring.

Step 7

Place the 4mm Emerald crystal round bead on a head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin, attaching the loop just made to the 8mm jump ring from Step 6 before completing the loop.

Step 8

Repeat Step 7 using a 4mm Peridot crystal round bead.

Step 9

Repeat Step 7 using a 4mm Fuchsia crystal round bead and a Thai Hill Tribe silver flower head pin.

Step 10

Repeat Step 7 using a 4mm Amethyst crystal round bead and a Thai Hill Tribe silver flower head pin.

Step 11

Open two 5mm jump rings. Use one to attach the Thai Hill Tribe silver heart charm to the 8mm jump ring and the other to attach the Thai Hill Tribe silver leaf charm to the same jump ring. Close both jump rings.

Step 12

Open the last 5mm jump ring. Allowing all the charms and bead units to dangle from one side of the 8mm jump ring, place the 5mm jump ring onto the side of the 8mm jump ring away from the beads, and attach the ring side of the toggle clasp. Close the jump ring.

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
