# Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 5 8mm Burgundy Swarovski Elements Crystal Pearls (PL5506)
- 1 bag Size 8 Opaque Lilac Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB0849)
- 1 bag 2x4mm Opaque Purple/Gold Luster Peanut Japanese Seed Beads (SB3906)
- 1 bag 2x4mm Opaque Pale Sage Green Peanut Japanese Seed Beads (SB3901)
- 1 bag 2x4mm Opaque Sage Green Luster Peanut Japanese Seed Beads (SB3907)
- 1 13mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Classic Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2143)
- 1 Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)

Scissors Perfect End Thread Burner Size 10 English Beading Needles

Spiral Rope Chain Using a Perfect End Thread Burner

## Instructions to complete "Spiral Garland" bracelet:

# Step 1

Thread a needle with a 6-foot length of beading thread (see Spiral Rope Chain Technique).

#### Step 2

Leave a 6-inch tail of thread. Weave eight stitches (repeating Step 14 of the technique six times) of a spiral rope chain using size 8 opaque lilac round seed beads as the core beads and the following pattern of beads as the outer spiral:

- 1 2x4mm opaque pale sage green peanut seed bead
- 1 2x4mm opaque sage green luster peanut seed bead
- 1 2x4mm opaque purple/gold luster peanut seed bead
- 1 2x4mm opaque sage green luster peanut seed bead
- 1 2x4mm opaque pale sage green peanut seed bead

# Step 3

String one pearl.

## Step 4

Beginning with Step 7 of the technique (four core beads in the first stitch only), weave eight stitches of spiral rope chain in the same pattern as Step 2. String one pearl.

## Step 5

Repeat Step 4 four times.

# Step 6

String one side of the toggle clasp. Pass through the last five outer spiral beads, the last four core beads and the clasp. Reinforce at least four times to ensure the clasp is secure. Burn the thread with a Perfect End Thread Burner (see Using a Perfect End Thread Burner Technique).

## Step 7

Pass back through all core beads and pearls the entire length of the bracelet. Repeat Step 6 to attach the other side of the clasp.
