Instructions to complete "The Wind Beneath My Wings" necklace:

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut the sterling silver chain into the following lengths:

1 - 0.75" length

1 - 1.5" length

1 - 4.5" length

Step 2

Cut the brass chain into the following lengths:

1 - 0.75" length

1 - 4.5" length

Step 3

Place the 6mm Light Colorado Topaz crystal rondelle onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to one end link of the 1.5-inch length of sterling silver chain.

Step 4

In the same manner as in the previous step, wire wrap the following bead units to the specified links on the same 1.5-inch length of chain:

4th link: the 6mm Light Colorado Topaz cube bead

9th link: the 12x8mm Light Colorado Topaz Polygon bead

10th link: the 6mm Padparadscha rondelle

11th link: the 8mm Light Colorado Topaz cube bead

Step 5

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to connect the 11x5.5mm Padparadscha crystal pendant to the second link on the same 1.5-inch length of chain from the previous steps. Close the jump ring.

Step 6

In the same manner as in the previous step, use the specified jump rings to attach the following pendants to the specified chain links on the same length of chain:

5th link: 5.5mm jump ring and the 13x6.5mm Light Colorado Topaz pendant

6th link: 5.5mm jump ring and the 13x6.5mm Padparadscha pendant

7th link: 5.5mm jump ring and the 17mm Crystal Golden Shadow Polygon pendant

Last link: 5.5mm jump ring and the brass heart pendant

Step 7

Open one 5.5mm jump ring. Use the jump ring to connect one end link of the 0.75-inch length of brass chain, the first link of the silver chain used in Steps 3 – 6 and one end link of the 0.75-inch length of silver chain so that the embellished chain hangs between the other two chains. Close the jump ring.

Step 8

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to connect the other end link on the 0.75-inch length of brass chain to the lower loop on the leaf link. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to connect the upper loop on the leaf link to one end link of the 4.5-inch length of brass chain. Close the jump ring.

Step 10

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to connect the other end link on the 0.75-inch length of silver chain to the loop on the beak side of the sparrow pendant. Close the jump ring.

Step 11

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to connect the loop on the tail side of the sparrow pendant to one end link of the 4.5-inch length of silver chain. Close the jump ring.

Step 12

Using a 3-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link (see Wire Wrapped Link Technique) with one 4mm Padparadscha crystal bicone bead. Attach one side of this wire wrapped link to the unattached end link on the 4.5-inch length of brass chain. Attach the other side of the wire wrapped link to the loop on the lobster claw clasp.

Step 13

In the same manner as in the previous step, make a wire wrapped link with one 4mm Padparadscha crystal bicone bead. Attach one side of this wire wrapped link to the unattached end link on the 4.5-inch length of silver chain. Attach the other side of the wire wrapped link to the closed jump ring.
