

# Peas in a Pod by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

6 - 5mm Dark Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Pearls (PL6313)  
6 - 6mm Dark Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Pearls (PL5309)  
3 - 8mm Light Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Pearls (PL5508)  
1 - 11.5x6mm Sterling Silver Oval Lobster Claw Clasp (SS4076)  
2 - 5.5mm Sterling Silver 20.5 Gauge Open Jump Rings (SS3922)  
6 feet - 26 Gauge Sterling Silver Half Hard Wire (SW0144)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Wire Wrapped Link  
Wire Herringbone

## **Instructions to complete “Peas in a Pod” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Using about 3 feet of wire, wrap three 8mm Light Green crystal pearls with a herringbone wrap (see Wire Herringbone Technique). Make 18 wrapped coils and 9 wraps around the beads. Make a loop on each end as in the technique.

### **Step 2**

Using a 2-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link (see Wire Wrapped Link Technique) with one 5mm Dark Green crystal pearl. Attach one side of this wire wrapped link to one loop on the wire herringbone component completed in Step 1, and complete the other side of this link without connecting it to anything.

### **Step 3**

In the same manner as in the previous step, continue making wire wrapped links using one bead per link and connecting them in the sequence listed below. Each wire wrapped link connects to the link listed directly before and directly after it:

- 1 – 6mm Dark Green crystal pearl
- 1 – 5mm Dark Green crystal pearl
- 1 – 6mm Dark Green crystal pearl
- 1 – 5mm Dark Green crystal pearl
- 1 – 6mm Dark Green crystal pearl

### **Step 4**

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the last loop made in the previous step to the loop on the lobster claw. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 5**

Repeat Steps 2 – 3 on the other side of the wire herringbone component.

### **Step 6**

Open one jump ring, and attach it to the last loop made in the previous step. Close the jump ring.

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
