
# Star Spiraled Banner by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.75 inches

## Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

2 grams - Size 11 Silver Lined Cranberry Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB2097)

2 grams - Size 11 Ceylon White Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1378)

2 grams - Size 8 White Luster Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB0947)

71 - 4mm Light Sapphire Swarovski Crystal Bicone Beads - 5328 (04BI1125)

1 - Pewter Bar and Ring Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® - Silver - 16mm (SP2129)

6 feet - FireLine Braided Bead Thread - Crystal Clear - 6 lb - 15 yard spool (SM6281)

## Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

English Beading Needles, Size 10 Scissors Perfect End Thread Burner

## Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Spiral Rope Chain
Using a Perfect End Thread Burner

## **Instructions to complete "Star Spiraled Banner" bracelet:**

#### Step 1

Thread a needle with a 6-foot length of beading thread. Attach a stopper bead (see Spiral Rope Chain Technique).

#### Step 2

Weave a spiral rope chain to the desired length using size 8 seed beads as the core beads and the following pattern of beads as the outer spiral:

- 1 size 11 silver lined cranberry seed bead
- 1 size 11 ceylon white seed bead
- 1 4mm Sapphire bicone bead
- 1 size 11 ceylon white seed bead
- 1 size 11 silver lined cranberry seed bead

#### Step 3

String two size 8 seed beads (these added beads will give the toggle bar room to pivot). String the loop on the bar side of the toggle clasp. Pass through the two size 8 seed beads, the last three outer spiral beads, the last four core beads and the clasp. Reinforce at least four times to ensure the clasp is secure. Burn the thread with a Perfect End Thread Burner (see Using a Perfect End Thread Burner Technique).

## Step 4

Thread a needle onto the tail at the beginning of the spiral rope. In the same manner as in the previous step, attach and reinforce the other side of the clasp.

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
