- 16 - 4mm Jonquil Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1102)
- 8 - 4mm Chrysolite Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1115)
- 16 - 4mm Silk Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1287)
- 6 - 5mm Air Blue Opal Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05BI1222)
- 8 - 5mm Chrysolite Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05BI1139)
- 16 - 5mm Peridot Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05BI1140)
- 16 - 5mm Light Azore Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05BI1152)
- 16 - 5mm Light Sapphire Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05BI1153)
- 6 - 6mm Air Blue Opal Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (06BI1382)
- 1 - 12x4.5mm Sterling Silver Lobster Claw Clasp with Ring (SS4070)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Simple Loop

## **Instructions to complete “Spring Meadow” necklace:**

### **Step 1**

Measure and identify the link 7 inches from one end of the 17-inch length of chain.

### **Step 2**

Place one 4mm Silk crystal bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to the link identified in the previous step.

### **Step 3**

Repeat Step 2 three times, using head pins and simple loops to attach three more 4mm Silk crystal bicone beads onto the same chain link, two on each side of the link.

### **Step 4**

In the same manner as in the previous steps, use head pins and simple loops to attach these beads to the specified chain links (the chain link used in previous steps is counted as the first link. Count links in the direction toward the longer end of the chain):

2<sup>nd</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Silk bicone beads

3<sup>rd</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Jonquil bicone beads

4<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Jonquil bicone beads

5<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Chrysolite bicone beads

6<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Chrysolite bicone beads

7<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Peridot bicone beads

8<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Peridot bicone beads

9<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Azore bicone beads

10<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Azore bicone beads

11<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Sapphire bicone beads

12<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Sapphire bicone beads

13<sup>th</sup> link: 2 – 5mm Air Blue Opal bicone beads, 2 – 6mm Air Blue Opal bicone beads

14<sup>th</sup> link: 2 – 5mm Air Blue Opal bicone beads, 2 – 6mm Air Blue Opal bicone beads

15<sup>th</sup> link: 2 – 5mm Air Blue Opal bicone beads, 2 – 6mm Air Blue Opal bicone beads

16<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Sapphire bicone beads

17<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Sapphire bicone beads

18<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Azore bicone beads

19<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Light Azore bicone beads

20<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Peridot bicone beads

21<sup>st</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Peridot bicone beads

22<sup>nd</sup> link: 4 – 5mm Chrysolite bicone beads

23<sup>rd</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Chrysolite bicone beads

24<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Jonquil bicone beads

25<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Jonquil bicone beads

26<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Silk bicone beads

27<sup>th</sup> link: 4 – 4mm Silk bicone beads

### **Step 5**

Open the jump ring attached to the lobster claw clasp (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and attach it to one end of the necklace. Close the jump ring.

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
