Approximate finished length: 17.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 6 - 6x10mm Antique Brass Plated Pewter Joy Large Hole Beads by TierraCast® (AP0134)
- 1 - 7mm Transparent Rose Gold Handmade Etched Glass Bead by T-Beads (HM0226)
- 1 - 25mm Black Lip Shell Round Pendant (PE6009)
- 1 - 35mm Black Tab Shell Round Pendant (PE6014)
- 2 - Hemp Twine Mini Card - Turquoise - 1.5mm - 20 lb test (SM5292)
- 1 - 10mm Natural Brass 16 Gauge Jump Ring by Vintaj (NB0340)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

Chain nose pliers
Hypo Tube Cement (TL1202)
Scissors
Clipboard
Ruler

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Macrame - Half Knot Spiral

Instructions to complete "Seaside Treasures" necklace:

Step 1

Open the jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). String the 25mm black lip shell pendant and the 35mm black tab shell pendant onto the jump ring. Close the jump ring.

Step 2

Using blue hemp twine, make a 17.5-inch macramé cord (see Macrame - Half Knot Spiral Technique). Place one pewter joy bead at the following locations in the macramé cord according to the technique (Step 12), measuring from the beginning end of the cord:

4.5 inches

5.75 inches

7 inches

Step 3

At the point 8.5 inches from the end, string the jump ring from Step 1 as you would string a bead according to the technique.

Step 4

In the same manner as in Step 2, continue making the macramé cord and placing one pewter job bead at the following locations (measuring from the same end of the cord):

9.5 inches

10.75 inches

12 inches

Step 5

Finish the cord with the transparent rose gold handmade etched glass bead as a button.

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
