

Studded Crimson by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 6.25 inches (wrapped three times)

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 5 - 4mm Siam Swarovski Elements Crystal Rose Montees (EW1109)
- 4 - 4mm Black Diamond Swarovski Elements Crystal Rose Montees (EW1112)
- 4 - 4mm Light Siam Swarovski Elements Crystal Rose Montees (EW1114)
- 1 - 5mm Red Suede Lace (SM5135)
- 8 inches - 24 Gauge Non-Tarnish Silver Artistic Wire (AW2117)
- 1 - Smoke Gray FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM1001)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Chain nose pliers
- Scissors
- Size 12 English Beading Needles (TL1647)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Attaching a Cord End – Style 6

Instructions to complete “Studded Crimson” bracelet:

Step 1

Using scissors, cut one 20-inch length of leather lace.

Step 2

Fold one half-inch of one end of the lace down, forming a loop. Using a 4-inch length of wire, wrap the wire around the lace to secure the loop (see Attaching a Cord End – Style 6 Technique).

Step 3

Repeat Step 2 on the other end of the lace.

Step 4

Thread a needle with an 18-inch length of beading thread. Tie knots in one end of the thread, and sew through the leather lace about 6 inches from one end.

Step 5

Sew through one Siam rose montee, pull the rose montee against the lace, and pass the needle through the lace again, securing the rose montee. Stitch across the back of the lace, and sew back up to the front of the lace about a half-inch from the previous rose montee.

Step 6

In the same manner as in the previous step, continue sewing rose montees to the leather lace about a half-inch apart in the following sequence:

1 – Black Diamond rose montee

1 – Light Siam rose montee

1 – Siam rose montee

Repeat the sequence three times.

Step 7

Secure the thread with a knot on the back side of the lace, and trim the thread.

Step 8

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the loop on the lobster claw to one folded loop in the leather lace. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Open one jump ring, and attach it to the second loop in the leather lace. Close the jump ring.

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
