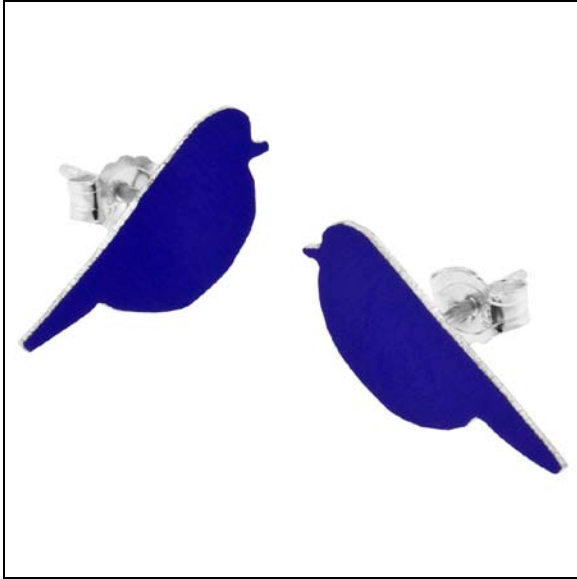


Blue Bird by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 0.25 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 1 - 3x3 inch 24 Gauge Purple Anodized Aluminum Sheet Metal by Lillypilly Designs (ME1060)
- 1 pair - 5mm Sterling Silver Flat Glue On Posts (SS2610)
- 1 pair - 4mm Sterling Silver Earring Backs (SS2611)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

- Scissors
- 5 Minute Epoxy (TL1938)
- Saw Frame 5 in. Adjustable (TL0610)
- Antelope Saw Blade - 2 Cut (TL0611)
- Cut Lube (TL2233)
- V-Slot Bench Pin with Clamp (TL2375)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

- Setting up the Saw Blade in the Saw Frame
- Sawing a Design Out of Sheet Metal

Instructions to complete “Blue Bird” earrings:

Step 1

Set up the saw blade (see Setting up the Saw Blade in the Saw Frame Technique).

Step 2

Print the images below onto label paper (see Sawing a Design Out of Sheet Metal Technique). Adhere the label to the sheet metal. Using the label images as a template, cut the shapes from the sheet metal.



Step 3

Using 5 Minute Epoxy, adhere each piece to one ear post, reversing one image to make a mirrored pair.
