## Chasing Rainbows Bracelet by FusionBeads.com

## Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

1-21x11.5mm Amethyst Enameled Copper S Clasp (AW8683)
4 packs (approximately 26 of each color) - 5.6 mm Rainbow 18g Jump Ring Mix (AW8651)
1 pack - 5.6 mm Fuchsia 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (AW8456)
1 jump ring - 8.5 mm Fuchsia 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (AW8461)

## Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Chain nose pliers

## Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Byzantine Chain Maille

## Instructions to complete "Chasing Rainbows Bracelet" bracelet:

## Step 1

Using about 26 purple jump rings from the 5.6 mm rainbow jump ring mix and the 5.6 mm fuchsia jump ring pack, make Byzantine chain maille through Step 17 of the technique (see Byzantine Chain Maille Technique). Continue making chain maille using these colors in the following sequence so that each color length is approximately the same as the purple:
dark blue
light blue
green
yellow
orange
magenta
fuchsia

## Step 2

Open one 8.5 mm fuchsia jump ring, and attach it to the last fuchsia pair of jump rings. Close the jump ring.

## Step 3

Open one 5.6 mm purple jump ring, and use it to attach the S hook clasp to the opposite end of the bracelet. Close the jump ring.
