

Summer Goldenrod Bracelet by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 1 - 21x11.5mm Silver Enameled Copper S Clasp (AW8674)
- 96 - 5mm Yellow 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (AW8125)
- 36 - 5mm Peridot 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (AW8118)
- 48 - 5mm Pacific Blue 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (AW8123)
- 2 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 18 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2832)
- 99 - 7mm Non-Tarnish Silver 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (AW8215)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Chain nose pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Japanese 12-in-2 Chain Maille

Instructions to complete “Summer Goldenrod” bracelet:

Step 1

Use 7mm silver, 5mm blue and 5mm yellow jump rings to make a unit of Japanese 12-in-2 chain maille (see Japanese 12-in-2 Chain Maille Technique). In Steps 1 – 5 of the technique, yellow jump rings will be used where they are shown in blue. In Steps 7 – 12 of the technique, blue jump rings will be used where they are shown in blue linking the outer petals.

Step 2

Repeat Step 1 three times, making three more chain maille units.

Step 3

In the same manner as in the previous steps, make three more chain maille units using peridot jump rings in place of the blue.

Step 4

Using two 5mm yellow jump rings, attach one petal of one blue unit to one petal of one peridot unit.

Step 5

In the same manner as in the previous steps, continue to use pairs of 5mm yellow jump rings to connect the units into a chain, alternating blue units and peridot units.

Step 6

Use one 5mm silver jump ring to attach one 7mm silver jump ring to the last chain maille unit.

Step 7

Use one 5mm silver jump ring to attach the S hook clasp to the opposite end of the bracelet.
