1 - Pewter Round Spiral Button - Antique Silver - 16mm (PW1764)
1 - 17.5 mm Antique Brass Plated Pewter Round Coin Button by TierraCast® (AP2139)
1 - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread . 008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)
20 inches - 1.5 mm Gunmetal Leather Cord (SM5217)
22 inches - 1.5 mm Metallic Gold Round Leather Cord (SM5079)
1 - \#18 Light Gray Superlon Bead Cord (SM4503)

## Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelets:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Crimping
Crimping Beads onto Beading Wire
Attaching a Cord End - Style 6
Lark's Head Knot
Adjustable Knot
Wrapped Cord Bracelet

## Instructions to complete "Glitter and Glam" bracelets:

Bracelets are numbered 1-5 from left to right in the photo above.

Bracelet 1:

2 inches - 12.5 mm Gold Plated Heavy Textured Oval Long \& Short Chain (CN3160)
10 inches - 1.5 mm Metallic Gold Round Leather Cord (SM5079)
1 - $12 \times 7 \mathrm{~mm}$ Gold Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3151)
2 - $7 \times 4.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ Gold Vermeil Extra Small Ribbon Ends (VG0247)
2 - 5 mm Gold Plated Base Metal 19 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2792)

## Step 1

Using scissors, cut the 1.5 mm metallic gold round leather cord into two 5-inch lengths.

## Step 2

The 12.5 mm gold plated heavy textured oval long and short chain is made of a single large oval link alternating with three small links. Using wire cutters, cut a 2inch length of chain so that it ends and begins with a single large oval link.

## Step 3

Fold one cord length in half, and use a lark's head knot (see Lark's Head Knot Technique) to tie the fold in the cord onto one end link of chain.

## Step 4

Holding the two cord ends together, apply a dot of Hypo Tube Cement to the ends of the cords. Attach one ribbon end to the two cord ends, and squeeze the ribbon end closed with chain nose pliers.

## Step 5

Repeat Steps 3 - 4 on the opposite end of the chain.

## Step 6

Open two jump rings (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use one jump ring to attach the loop on the lobster claw clasp to one ribbon end. Attach the second jump ring to the second ribbon end. Close both jump rings.

Bracelet 2:
Beads and other products needed for Bracelet 2:
6 - 4mm Black Diamond Swarovski Elements Crystal Rose Montees (EW1112)
4 feet - Extreme Soft Flex . 014 Sterling Silver Plated Wire (SM4372)
1 - $16 \times 12 \mathrm{~mm}$ Silver Plated Pewter Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2129)
14 - $2 \times 2 \mathrm{~mm}$ Sterling Silver Crimp Beads (SS4047)

## Tip

Wrap this bracelet twice around your wrist.

## Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut three 16 -inch lengths of beading wire.

## Step 2

Place one crimp bead and the loop on one side of the toggle clasp onto all three lengths of beading wire. Pass the wires back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

## Step 3

String one crimp bead onto all three lengths of beading wire 1.5 inches from the previous crimp bead. Using chain nose pliers, crimp the crimp bead flat (see Crimping Beads onto Beading Wire Technique).

## Step 4

String one rose montee and one crimp bead onto all three lengths of beading wire. Crimp the crimp bead flat about 0.5 inch from the previous crimp bead.

## Step 5

Repeat Steps 3 - 4 five times.

## Step 6

Repeat Step 2 on the other end of the beading wires.
Bracelet 3:
Beads and other products needed for Bracelet 3:
4-4mm Silver Plated Crystal Rhinestone Chain (CN9508)
1 - \#18 Light Gray Superlon Bead Cord (SM4503)
1 - Silver Flat Memory Wire 2.25 inch Diameter Bracelet (SM5225

## Step 1

Tie the end of the Superlon bead cord around one end of the Memory Wire. Apply a small drop of Hypo Cement to the knot, and allow it to dry.

## Step 2

Hold one end of the rhinestone chain against the Memory Wire. Wrap the bead cord around both the chain and the Memory wire between the first and second rhinestones.

## Step 3

In the same manner as in the previous step, continue to wrap the chain and the Memory Wire together with the bead cord by wrapping it between the rhinestones.

## Step 4

When you reach the end of the Memory Wire, cut the chain to the same length as the wire, and tie a knot in the cord around the wire. Apply a small drop of Hypo Cement to the knot, and allow it to dry.

## Bracelet 4:

Beads and other products needed for Bracelet 4:
9-4.5x8mm Gunmetal Czech Pressed Glass Spike Beads (GL3570)
20 - 5 mm Metallic Nickel Plated 2 Hole Tila Seed Beads by Miyuki (SB4123)
1 - Pewter Round Spiral Button - Antique Silver - 16mm (PW1764)20 inches - 1.5mm Gunmetal Leather Cord (SM5217)
1 - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread . 008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)

## Step 1

Using scissors, cut a 20-inch length of 1.5 mm gunmetal leather cord.

## Step 2

String the spiral button onto the cord to the middle of the cord. Tie an overhand knot just below the button. Clip the button to a clip board (see Wrapped Cord Bracelet Technique).

## Step 3

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread. Attach the thread to the cord. Wrap these beads, one at a time, in the following sequence into a bracelet:
2 - Tila beads
1 - spike bead
Repeat the sequence nine times, omitting the spike bead from the last repeat.
Step 4
Finish off the beading thread according to the Technique.
Step 5
Trim excess thread with scissors. Place a drop of glue on each thread knot. Allow the glue to dry.

## Step 6

Tie an overhand knot after the last bead. Make one buttonhole according to the Technique. Trim excess cord.

Bracelet 5:
Beads and other products needed for Bracelet 5:
1-17.5mm Antique Brass Plated Pewter Round Coin Button by TierraCast® (AP2139)
12 inches - 1.5 mm Metallic Gold Round Leather Cord (SM5079)

## Step 1

Using scissors, cut the 1.5 mm metallic gold round leather cord into two 6-inch lengths.

Step 2
String each length through one hole in the coin button.
Step 3
Tie the two cords together with an adjustable knot (see Adjustable Knot Technique).
