

# Vintage Christmas by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 4 - 10mm Light Siam Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9188)
- 4 - 10mm Fern Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9186)
- 4 - 10mm Amethyst Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9182)
- 4 - 10mm Aquamarine Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9183)
- 3 - 10mm Light Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9189)
- 6 inches - 4mm Stainless Steel Oval Cable Chain (CN7108)
- 1 - 20.5x15.5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Large Tapered Toggle Clasp by TierraCast (SP2147)
- 19 - 7mm Silver Plated Base Metal Filigree Bead Caps (BM2930)
- 19 - 22 gauge Silver Plated Brass 2 inch Head Pins (BM2703)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Wire Wrapping

## **Instructions to complete “Vintage Christmas” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Place one 10mm Amethyst crystal Globe bead and one bead cap onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to the second chain link on the 6-inch length of chain.

### **Step 2**

In the same manner in the previous step, wire wrap each of these beads in the following sequence, skipping one chain link after each attachment:

1 – 10mm Fern Green Globe bead, 1 – bead cap

1 – 10mm Aquamarine Globe bead, 1 – bead cap

1 – 10mm Light Siam Globe bead, 1 – bead cap

1 – 10mm Light Topaz Globe bead, 1 – bead cap

### **Step 3**

Repeat Steps 1 – 2 three times, maintaining the pattern sequence and omitting the Light Topaz unit from the last repeat.

### **Step 4**

Open the first chain link (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique) and attach to one side of the toggle. Open the last chain link and attach it to the other side of the clasp. Close both links
