1722/1 H copper sou or 9 deniers of the **French Colonies** VF, moderate corrosion \$227.

1748 brass weight for a Portuguese moidore or 4000 reis gold coin of the 1720-30s. The moidore traded for about \$6. US in the 1790s. Name in wreath, cross of Jerusalem. EF+, Itly cld \$137.

1769 gold ducat of Holland, nicely mounted in unmarked gold bezel, ready to wear. Obv: knight with sword and arrows Rev: plaque \$537.

1783 gold zeri mahbub of the Ottoman empire, more commonly known to American merchants as a "**sequin**". They usually traded for \$2 to \$2.35 US. NGC MS 63 amazing surfaces, on sale \$977.

1789 silver 2 bits Mex VG \$57.

1792-K bronze 12 deniers 29mm of Louis 16th of France, who lost his head very nice Fine + \$77.

Early US Silver Dollars

1836 **Gobrecht** silver dollar, original striking of 1836, coin alignment with eagle flying upwards. Pleasing light surfaces. PCGS XF 40 \$18,700.

1836 Gobrecht silver dollar, original striking of Feb-Mar 1837, **medal turn**. One of 600 coins struck to celebrate official opening of new mint using new steam presses. PCGS Proof 55 \$21,700. Light toning with nice eye appeal.

1846/46 Liberty seated dollar. This heavily repunched date, way out of register, occurs only on proofs. Maybe 40 were struck, and maybe only 30 exist now. PCGS PR 58 \$8700.

1870-P ICG AU 58 \$1477.

1872-P ANACS **MS 60** details, **cleaned** (very gently) \$2477.
