1771 December Province of North Carolina uncut sheets of colonial currency. Two shillings sixpence, 20 shillings or One pound, and Ten shillings note per sheet. Signed but unissued bundle of 50 sheets tied together at top through 2sh/6d notes. These were bought by a Tory family on speculation of later redemption, which never happened. The family donated them to the New York public library, which deaccessioned them. Colonial Williamsburg has half the hoard, and this is your opportunity. Before the recession I sold these bundles to a dealer for \$60,000. Your price now only \$33,700. Only two bundles available.
