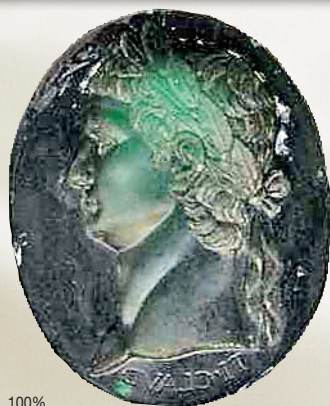

Glass seal of Tiberius Caesar, stepson of Augustus, who outlived all his rivals to the throne, possibly with the aid of his scheming mother Livia. \$477.

14-37 AD aureus of Tiberius, the so called "Tribute penny in gold" Same designs as denarius. Raw Abt Unc \$12,700.

Glass seal of Gaius Caesar, popularly known as Caligula. English, c. 1800 \$775.

14-37 AD bronze (semis size) of Tiberius from the Roman colony of Philippi in Macedonia. Obv: his bust Rev: two priest ploughing with oxen. Many retired legionaires received farmland in many parts of the empire, frequently being awarded the amount of land which they could plow a boundary around in a day. NGC Ch XF\* nice dark green patina \$377. Rare grade.

40 AD gold aureus of Caligula, Lugdunum mint in Gaul Obv: his laureate bust Rev: SPQR PP O.B.C.S in wreath Raw EF+ \$77,000.

14-37 AD denarius, or silver Tribute Penny of the Bible Obv: laureate bust of Tiberius, who appointed Pontius Pilate Rev: Livia, mother of Tiberius, second wife of Augustus NGC Ch VF great centering and luster, \$877.

37-41 AD silver denarius of Caligula, Obv: his bare head Rev: bare head of his father Germanicus, raw VG \$2477.

37-41 AD silver denarius of Caligula Obv: his bare head Rev: radiate bust of his grandfather Augustus NGC XF, scuff (faint abrasion on forehead and cheekbone) \$9775.

37-41 AD bronze As of Caligula Obv: his bare head Rev: Vesta enthroned, holding scepter and patera Raw EF+, mostly brown patina with some faint smoothing \$2775.

40 AD bronze quadrans of Caligula, Rome mint, to commemorate Caligula removing the 1/2 sales tax on auctions. Obv: Liberty cap, SC Rev: RCC, legend EF, some light deposits \$227. VF uneven patina \$147.

41-54 AD silver denarius of Claudius Obv: his laureate bust Rev: Nemesis holding long caduceus, snake before Raw near VF/F but surfaces corroded \$1177.

Another Claudius/Nemesis denarius, more even Fine, dark, some light planchet roughness \$977.

54-68 AD gold aureus of the infamous Nero, last of the Julio-Claudians. Rome mint Obv: his laureate bust Rev: Jupiter enthroned, holding scepter and thunderbolt NGC VG \$2775.

Silver denarius, same designs, raw VF Pleasing big planchet \$977. Another raw G/AG \$127.

54-68 AD brass sestertius of Nero. Obv: his harsh, debauched countenance in fine style, laureate bust left Rev: equally fine style of helmeted Roma, seated on armour and shields, holding Victory and parazonium. EF, some minor problems which disappear amidst the overall superb eye appeal. \$4700.

66-67 AD silver denarius, Rome mint Obv: laureate bust right Rev: Salus enthroned ICG VF 30 \$1277. Another NGC Ch Fine \$477.

54-68 AD silver denarius rev: temple of Vesta ICG VF 20 \$775.

54-68 AD bronze as, Lugdunum mint in Gaul, Obv: bare head of Nero Rev: Victory flying, holding shield inscribed SPQR Raw EF, slightly uneven strike, slightly grainy surface, very nice brown color \$775.

54-68 AD silver tetradrachm of Nero from Antioch Obv: his laureate bust Rev: eagle VF \$377.
