<b>02</b> JESUS RESET <b>FAIRNESS</b> FEB 28 - MARCH 01	<p><b>UNFAIRNESS CHALLENGE:</b> extend grace/ blessing to an "enemy," person in group, or keep an eye out for someone to surprise</p>	<p>Unique claims of Jesus vs. other religions and how Grace is what is most unique about Jesus</p>	<p>Turning our innate desire for fairness to a desire for and acceptance of grace; burning a list of sins</p>	<p>Unique claims of Jesus, the unfairness of grace, a personal testimony of accepting Jesus in prison</p>	<p>Debrief challenge; reaction to grace prompts from guide; share what you're wrestling with right now</p>
<b>03</b> JESUS RESET <b>SURRENDER</b> MARCH 07-08	<p><b>COUNTERCULTURAL CHALLENGE:</b> pray for an "enemy," write a forgiveness letter, or give sacrificially of time or money</p>	<p>Historical context of Jesus' life, and what made him so revolutionary; what would his call look like today?</p>	<p>Understanding fears and desire for control; what makes us hesitant to surrender to Jesus' call to follow?</p>	<p>Why was Jesus revolutionary? What did that mean then, and today? The kingdom of God is a revolution</p>	<p>Debrief challenge; discuss fears and giving up control; what keeps us from surrendering more fully to Jesus?</p>
<b>04</b> JESUS RESET <b>LOVE</b> MARCH 14-15	<p><b>LISTEN TO MP3/ CD IN A CEMETERY</b> regarding emptying/ dying to self in order to be able to receive Jesus</p>	<p>Jesus' sacrifice as the ultimate act of love; what does it mean to receive and abide in Jesus' love? Challenge to receive Jesus</p>	<p>Receiving metaphors: parable of the soils, receiving as little children, the vine and branches (abiding), parable of the two sons</p>	<p>What does God's love look like? Ascribing worth to another at cost to oneself; we are God's adopted children</p>	<p>Debrief challenge; discuss receiving guide prompts; receive affirmation from one another; prayer requests</p>
<b>05</b> JESUS RESET <b>PRAYER</b> MARCH 21-22	<p><b>PRAY P-R-A-Y MODEL IN GUIDE EACH DAY</b>, including request from group; attend Prayer Experience</p>	<p>Urgency of prayer as spiritual warfare; importance of prayer in following Jesus; hearing from God</p>	<p>P-R-A-Y prompts: Praise, Repent, Ask and Yield (set up so people will do these 4x during the week)</p>	<p>Experiences with prayer; hearing God in prayer; how to begin to pray</p>	<p>Debrief challenge; share significant moment in prayer; continuous prayer possible/ practical?</p>
<b>06</b> JESUS RESET <b>CHURCH</b> MARCH 28-29	<p><b>MAKE SOMETHING "UNIQUELY YOU"</b> to share with the group</p>	<p>Evidence for the Resurrection; what is the Church, and what is it supposed to do? Jesus is alive in YOU</p>	<p>Explore dependence on others, life in community, where do you see God working? What's different now?</p>	<p>Implications of Resurrection; being part of the Church; what's the point, ultimately?</p>	<p>Pray together; share results of challenge with group; discuss what will be different now; celebrate!</p>
