

TICKET REGISTRATION FAQ's

101st PGA Championship



Q: What is PGA Championship Ticket Registration?

A: To ensure widespread access to the most in-demand ticket types, PGA Championship tickets are sold exclusively through a free, no obligation, online registration process. Fans can visit PGACHampionship.com to hold their place in line to purchase tickets when they go on sale in August of 2018. The earlier fans register the better, as historically many of the most popular ticket types sell out well in advance of the Championship.

Q: How do I register for tickets?

A: Beginning in May, fans should visit PGACHampionship.com and follow the links to 2019. Once on the site, click on "Tickets" in the top menu bar to launch the official registration page. Follow instructions to complete the registration form.

Q: How does it work?

A: Once registered, the PGA of America sends all ticket registrants a confirmation "Thank You for Registering" email outlining their "purchase window". We advise all registrants to hold onto their "Thank You for Registering" email, as well as its automatic calendar reminder to alert you as to your future purchase window. Purchase windows are determined by the date registration is received and will begin in August. We anticipate purchase windows extending well into September, and even early October. As such, registrants need not be alarmed by their purchase position.

Q: What types of tickets are available?

A: There will be a variety of options available from daily tickets to week-long packages. Both upgraded and standard access offerings will be available.

Q: How much will tickets cost?

A: Week-long and daily ticket pricing will be announced at a later date, along with a few special announcements on how we'll be incorporating exclusive access to 2024 Ryder Cup tickets through an "Ultimate Wanamaker" ticket offering.

Q: Does the PGA offer Junior Tickets?

A: Juniors 17 years of age and younger will be admitted into the Championship grounds FREE when accompanied by a ticketed adult. Each ticketed adult will be permitted four (4) junior grounds admissions per day at no additional charge. Junior tickets may be picked-up onsite at the Admission Sales & Will Call Office at the Championship main entrance on the day of admission. Junior tickets cannot be obtained in advance and will be available regardless of a sell-out.

Q: Does the PGA offer Military Tickets?

A: To honor the men and women who serve our country in the Armed Forces, the Championship is pleased to offer Active Duty, Retirees*, Reserve, National Guard and their accompanying guest (limit one) complimentary daily grounds access to the Championship, regardless of sell-out. Upon arrival, Military personnel must go to the Admissions Sales and Will Call Office at the Main Spectator Entrance to present their Military ID in exchange for daily admission. Please note, these tickets cannot be upgraded to alternative venues, but are eligible for the junior admission policy. (*Career-retired with twenty years of qualifying military service and Department of Defense ID)



Q: What is the “Ultimate Wanamaker” ticket package?

A: As the PGA of America and Bethpage State Park look forward to the 2024 Ryder Cup we are excited to provide a unique opportunity for golf fans to reserve access to the Ryder Cup when it comes to Bethpage Black in 2024. With the purchase of this offering, fans will be afforded an opportunity to bypass the standard Ryder Cup ticket lottery and purchase two (2) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup when they become available.

- The 2019 PGA Championship ticket types within this package and pricing are still to be determined and will be announced at a later date.
- When 2024 Ryder Cup tickets become available, purchasers of the “Ultimate Wanamaker” package will be notified and provided a unique link to purchase their two (2) week-long grounds passes. You will be required to log-in to your PGA Account using the same email address and password created upon purchasing the “Ultimate Wanamaker” package.
- The opportunity to bypass the lottery process and purchase two (2) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup will be non-transferrable.

Q: Can I purchase more than one (1) “Ultimate Wanamaker” ticket package?

A: Yes. Those purchasing two (2) “Ultimate Wanamaker” packages will gain access to four (4) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup, and so on. There will be a limit of five (5) “Ultimate Wanamaker” packages per transaction providing access to a maximum of ten (10) week-long grounds passes for the 2024 Ryder Cup.

Q: How many “Ultimate Wanamaker” ticket packages will be sold?

A: The PGA does not disclose inventory limits for any of its ticket options. What we can tell you is that only a limited number of these packages will be sold and that the expectation is they will sell-out well in advance of the Championship.

Q: When is the Ryder Cup at Bethpage State Park?

A: The Ryder Cup, typically held in the month of September, will be played at Bethpage State Park in 2024. Exact dates have yet to be determined for this historic event.
