# What to Change?

- More information from OCTAE staff
- Information on how all states are approaching a topic rather than a subset
- Increase call time
- Put all people on mute and make them type questions / ensure some don't dominate conversation
- Have participants submit questions for OCTAE before or during call

# Other Suggestions

- Invite NCES to give update on SCEDS codes
- Move away from 'reporting' to group input on topics
- Invite outside guests (e.g., for-profits)
- Good to hear about success; let's hear more about challenges
- Share participation lists with contact information to follow-up and talk with others
- Audio over computer
