

# GOOTOOLS

GOOTOOLS is a set of tools for the IBM i (AS/400) which enables you to exploit the free Google Docs service directly from your IBM i, without any other computers, or any programming whatsoever.

GOOTOOLS consists of two commands:

**GOOUPLOAD** - Upload documents such as Microsoft Word/Excel, OpenOffice, CSV and Text files to the Google Docs service so that they may be viewed and edited online from anywhere in the world.

**GOOSQL** - Execute an SQL statement and put the results directly into a Google Docs spreadsheet, making your SQL reports incredibly easy to view, search and edit on any computer with a web browser.

## GOOUPLOAD

To use GOOUPLOAD, you first need a Google/GMail account. Once you have this, you will have an email address and password for this service. On running the GOOUPLOAD command, enter your email address and password into the first two fields. Now enter the IFS path for the document you wish to upload, this can be anywhere on your server, or an NFS share. Now enter what you wish the document to be called on Google Docs. Google Docs tends to use filenames like "My First Novel", rather than "myfirstnovel.doc", but you can call your document anything you wish.

Once these fields are filled, you can hit enter and the upload will commence. GOOUPLOAD will report progress as the upload happens.
