
SDA HPERA Convention March 29, 2004

Adventist Education Forum

Follow the directions below on how to register and contribute your comments on the Adventist Education Forum (which has a specific section for Physical Education and Athletics) located at <http://edforum.adventist.org> (note there is not a www).

To Register as a member:

1. Go to the site using your internet browser
2. Click on “register”
3. Click on the appropriate birth information
4. Read the information. Click on “agree”
5. Enter your information and click on “submit”
6. Answer the additional profile information and click on “submit”
7. You are now a member. They will email your password to the address you provided.

To Post a new topic/question:

1. Scroll down to Physical Education/Athletics & click on it
2. Look for the blue outlined “New Topic”
3. Enter the appropriate info in each field (i.e. username, password, subject, message, etc)
4. You may want to click on the box which has them e-mail you when someone replies to your post
5. At the end of the “message”, put your name and e-mail address at the bottom so people can reply to you individually. They can click on “reply” on the web site to post a response to the web site.
6. Click on “Submit New Topic”

To Read topics:

1. Scroll down to Physical Education/Athletics & click on it
2. Click on the subject and read the message.
3. Use the web browser’s “Back” or “Forward” buttons to move in the internet.

To “Reply” to a topic post:

1. Read the posted message
2. Click on the blue outlined “Reply”

3. Enter your message and appropriate info (including your name and email at the end of your post) similar to posting a new topic
4. Click on “Submit Reply” or your message won’t be posted
