

BLACK METAL was disqualified from third and placed fourth for fouling ADMIRAL PORTER. The latter, a sharp factor from the start, raced with BLACK METAL after the break, was bumped repeatedly during the stretch run and could not be persevered with in the late stages, although giving a good effort. KING PHALANX lacked early speed, but finished strongly under dangerous and had no mishap. RED HANNIGAN gave way after racing well to the stretch. PINETUM was never dangerous and had no mishap. RED HANNIGAN gave way after racing well to the stretch. PINETUM was never prominent. SEA O ERIN was through after six furlongs. FOR FREE showed nothing.
