FIRST DUDE bounced around at the start, recovered to be close up along the inside, moved off the rail on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch but lacked a solid closing bid. INTERACTIF within striking distance three wide, moved four wide midway through the second turn, came six wide into the stretch but had nothing left late. CODDY outrun off the inside, remained well back while in the three path on the second turn and rallied belatedly. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME came in a bit at the start tightening up inner rivals, steadied near the first turn when AIKENITE angled in, was reserved four wide and could not threaten. PLEASANT PRINCE outrun three wide, was no factor. AIKENITE angled in early to race four wide while within striking distance, moved to the three path on the second turn but tired. ODYSSEUS bumped at the start, set the pace, held on well for six furlongs and stopped.

GENERAL QUARTERS close up early six wide, moved in a couple of path's on the backstretch while maintaining good position, challenged when ready midway through the second turn, drew clear from between rivals in upper stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. HOLD ME BACK reserved early six wide, angled in a bit before a half, launched his rally from the four path with three furlongs to go, came to the outside for the drive and finished willingly to be slowly cutting into the winner's margin late. MASSONE angled in on the first turn, moved up quickly along the inside in the run down the backstretch, challenged inside the leaders with five furlongs to go, stayed on well to the final furlong and weakened. TERRAIN outrun early while unhurried and four wide, commenced his bid with three furlongs to go, came to the outside for the drive and rallied willingly late. JOIN IN THE DANCE angled out in the run to the first turn, lead the field four wide into that bend, moved in a bid after a half, battled in the two path around the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired late. LOCH DUBH within striking distance four wide, moved to challenged from the five path approaching the stretch, raced with the winner into the lane but tired. CHARITABLE MAN seven wide early when within striking distance, angled in on the backstretch, moved to the rail with three furlongs to go but had no late bid. MAFAAZ (GB) broke in the air, recovered to be close up four wide, moved in to the three path for the second turn maintained good position to the stretch and tired. THEREGOESJOJO closes to the pace five wide, moved in to the three path on the second turn, held on well to the final quarter and faded. PATENA closer up three wide, held on well to 3/8 pl, gave way. CLIFFY'S FUTURE outrun from the start, was no factor.

MONBA, never far back and steadied slightly entering the backstretch between rivals, tracked front-running COWBOY CAL six wide, went after that one a quarter-mile out, then was fully extended to wear him down at the end. COWBOY CAL bumped at the start by STEVIL when that one leaned in, continued in bumping KENTUCKY BEAR, raced well off the inside while gaining a clear lead on the first turn, coasted along five or six wide on the backstretch, edged in entering the far turn, was engaged by MONBA coming to the quarter-mile marker, floated out entering the upper stretch to be six or seven wide into the upper stretch, then couldn't contain the winner in a game try. KENTUCKY BEAR, bumped soon after the break by COWBOY CAL when that one was forced in, raced within easy striking distance between foes five wide, came out nine wide for the drive, loomed menacingly for the last eighth but couldn't offer the needed late response. STEVIL drifted in at the break bumping COWBOY CAL, followed the leaders four or five wide, came out ten or twelve wide entering the upper stretch, altered course to be five wide in the final furlong, then failed to gain further. VISIONAIRE, outrun five wide for seven furlongs, came out twelve wide entering the stretch to secure room, then was slowly gaining in the late stages. MINER'S CLAIM, outrun early, raced three wide, advanced from that position on the track around the far turn, made a bold run leaving the quarter-mile ground but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. HALO NAJIB, outrun to the stretch and near the inside, improved position while unable to menace. MEDJOOL, rank behind horses when steadied repeatedly nearing the first turn, wasn't a factor. COOL COAL MAN, forwardly placed while tracking the leaders three or four wide, raced in a striking position to the head of the stretch and flattened out. PYRO broke a step slow, settled four wide while unhurried to the far turn, came out between foes five or six wide entering the upper stretch and never fired. BIG TRUCK raced in contention five wide from early on, was asked nearing the

entering the upper stretch and never free. Did FACCA Tacket in Contention free wine from early on, was seen hearing the five-sixteenths pole and tired. STONE BIRD, up close five wide early, faltered soon after going six furlongs.

DOMINICAN hopped slightly the start, quickly settled three or four wide, was asked to pick it up three furlongs out, worked his way out seven wide about the furlong grounds, then closed determinedly to be up in the last lunge. STREET SENSE, well in hand while following the leaders five wide from the outset, crept up four wide approaching the final quarter, was floated out seven wide by GREAT HUNTER when that one was forced out a bit in the upper stretch by TEUFLESBERG, was carried out for a stride at the sixteenth pole by TEUFLESBERG, stuck a head in front briefly approaching the wire but dropped a tough decision in the last stride. ZANJERO, up close from the outset while in hand two or three wide, made a bold run to poke his head in front briefly in the final sixteenth but was outfinished. TEUFLESBERG bobbled at the start, quickly recovered and galloped to a clear, easy lead while in hand, accomplished modest fractions, came out farther on the track entering the upper stretch, drifted out in front of GREAT HUNTER about the sixteenth pole when sharply roused left-handed forcing that one to take up, was straightened and continued on with good courage. GREAT HUNTER brushed the side of the gate at the break, went up to track front-running TEUFLESBERG in hand four wide, inched after the leader leaving the second turn, was floated out a bit by that one entering the lane, then was forced to take up when TEUFLESBERG drifted out at the sixteenth pole. TIME SQUARED, off a step slow, raced three or four wide, angled seven or eight wide leaving the second turn but offered no closing threat. LOVE DUBAI, slow to begin, raced three wide while unhurried, maneuvered out nine wide into the stretch and never menaced.

SONGANDAPRAYER went up early to press the winner under light rating, inched after MILLENNIUM WIND on the second turn, gained almost even terms, continued to challenge that one into the stretch, weakened gradually when straightened for the drive and drifted out for a stride leaving the eighth pole when roused with the whip left-handed. DOLLAR BILL, lightly bumped at the start when BONNIE SCOT leaned in, settled inside, was unhurried until the end of the backstretch, was asked a bit, continued inside into the stretch, angled three wide and improved position while not a serious threat. INVISIBLE INK, close up inside from the outset, eased out three wide approaching the second turn, was asked for his best leaving the three-eighths pole, remained prominent until the stretch but was empty the last eighth. A P VALENTINE, five or six wide into the backstretch, edged in around the second turn, continued three wide into the stretch and failed to menace. BONNIE SCOT leaned in at the start bumping lightly with DOLLAR BILL, angled inside early, appeared to be climbing on the backstretch, angled four or five wide into the stretch but flattened out. HERO'S TRIBUTE, taken in hand early to follow the leaders three or four wide, was put to a drive entering the second turn, but tired approaching the stretch.
