The Gospel of Grace Explained

- Gal 4:10
- 10 You are observing special days and months and seasons and years!
11 I fear for you, that somehow I have wasted my efforts on you.
- 12 I plead with you, brothers, become like me, **for I became like you.** You have done me no wrong.
 - Ref. Phil.3:4-10 -Paul describes for us what he means when he says, become like me.



The Gospel of Grace Explained

- Gal 4:13-14
- 13 As you know, it was because of an illness **that I first preached the gospel to you.** 14 Even though my illness was a trial to you, you did not treat me with contempt or scorn. Instead, you welcomed me as if I were an angel of God, as if I were Christ Jesus himself.



The Gospel of Grace Explained

- Gal 4:15-16
- **15 What has happened to all your joy?** I can testify that, if you could have done so, you would have torn out your eyes and given them to me.
- **16 Have I now become your enemy by telling you the truth?**



The Gospel of Grace Explained

- Gal 4:19-20
- 19 My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you, 20 how I wish I could be with you now and change my tone, because I am perplexed about you!



The Gospel of Grace Explained

- Gal 4:17-18
- 17 **Those people** are zealous to win you over, but for no good. **What they want is to alienate you [from us]**, so that you may be zealous for them. 18 It is fine to be zealous, provided the purpose is good, and to be so always and not just when I am with you.



The Just shall live by Faith

- **Hab 2:4**
- **4** Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: **but the just shall live by his faith.**

- **Rom 1:17**
- **17** For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, **The just shall live by faith.**

- **Gal 3:11**
- **11** But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, **The just shall live by faith.**

- **38** Now **the just shall live by faith:** but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him.
