

The highest level of faith that can be expressed regarding Divine healing is when one simply believes that God's Word heals them.

- Matt 8:7-8
- 7 And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.
- 8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

GREAT FAITH

- Matt 8:10
- ▶ 10 When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

- Luke 17:12-13
- ► 12 Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. 13 And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"



- Luke 17:14-16
- ► 14 So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.
- ▶ 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, 16 and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan.

- Luke 17:17-19
- ▶ 17 So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? 18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" 19 And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

HEALING

- lsa 53:4-5
- ▶ 4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- ▶ 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.



HEALING

- Matt 8:16-17
- ▶ 16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were <u>possessed with</u> <u>devils:</u> and he cast out the spirits with his word, and <u>healed all that were sick:</u>
- by Esaias the prophet, saying, <u>Himself took</u> our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.



HEALING

- ▶ 1 Peter 2:24
- ▶24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.



LAYING ON OF HANDS

- Acts 9:17
- ▶ 17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and <u>putting his hands on him said</u>,

 Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost.

THE LAYING ON OF HANDS

- Mark 16:16-18
- ▶ 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- ▶ 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- ▶ 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

THE LAYING ON OF HANDS

- ▶ Luke 13:13 -The Woman Bent Over
- ▶ 13 And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

SUMMON THE ELDERS

- James 5:14-15
- ▶ 14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- ▶ 15 And the <u>prayer of faith</u> shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

SUMMON THE ELDERS

Summoning the Elders is an act of honor, respect and submission to the Divine Order of God. God established the Church and uses the order to exercise His delegated authority. When one summons the Elders they are expressing faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as their healer and deliverer
