# THE FOUR QUESTIONS

- Rom 6:1-3
- 1. What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?

 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

 3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his <u>death?</u>

- Rom 6:4
- 4 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into <u>death</u>: that like as Christ was raised up from the <u>dead</u> by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

- Rom 6:5-7
- 5 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his **death**, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection:
- 6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
- 7 For he that is <u>dead</u> is freed from sin.

- Rom 6:8-10
- 8 Now if we be <u>dead</u> with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him:
- 9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the <u>dead</u> dieth no more; <u>death</u> hath no more dominion over him.
- 10 For in that he <u>died</u>, he <u>died</u> unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.

- Rom 6:11-13
- 11 <u>Likewise reckon</u> ye also yourselves to be <u>dead</u> indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.
- 13 Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

- Rom 6:14-16
- 14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.
- 15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.
- 16 Know ye not, that to whom ye <u>yield</u>
  yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye
  are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto
  death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

- Rom 6:17-18
- 17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.
- 18 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

- Rom 6:19-21
- 19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.
- 20 For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness.
- 21 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.

- Rom 6:22-23
- 22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.
- 23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
