






# THERE ARE NINE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT


- The Revelation Gifts (Reveal something)

# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

The definition of a true miracle is:

- a supernatural intervention in the ordinary course of nature, a temporary suspension of the accustomed order, or an interruption of the system of nature as we know it, operated by the force of the Holy Spirit
- A miracle is a supernatural act in the natural (worldly) realm



# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- Ex 14:21-22
- 21 Then Moses raised his hand over the sea, and the Lord opened up a path through the water with a strong east wind. The wind blew all that night, turning the seabed into dry land.
- 22 So the people of Israel walked through the middle of the sea on dry ground, with walls of water on each side!



# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- Josh 3:15-16
- 15 It was the harvest season, and the Jordan was overflowing its banks. But as soon as the feet of the priests who were carrying the Ark touched the water at the river's edge,
- .16 the water above that point began backing up a great distance away at a town called Adam, which is near Zarethan. And the water below that point flowed on to the Dead Sea until the riverbed was dry. Then all the people crossed over near the town of Jericho.



# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- 2 Kings 1:10
- 10 But Elijah replied to the captain, "If I am a man of God, let fire come down from heaven and destroy you and your fifty men!" Then fire fell from heaven and killed them all.
- 12, "If I am a man of God, let fire come down from heaven and destroy you and your fifty men!" And again the fire of God fell from heaven and killed them all.



# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- Ten plagues against Egypt (Exodus 7-14)
- This Working of Miracles was used for a miraculous deliverance of God's people
- Speaking a word and the sun stands still is a miracle (Joshua 10:12-13)
- Causing an ax head to float is a miracle (II Kings 6:6)



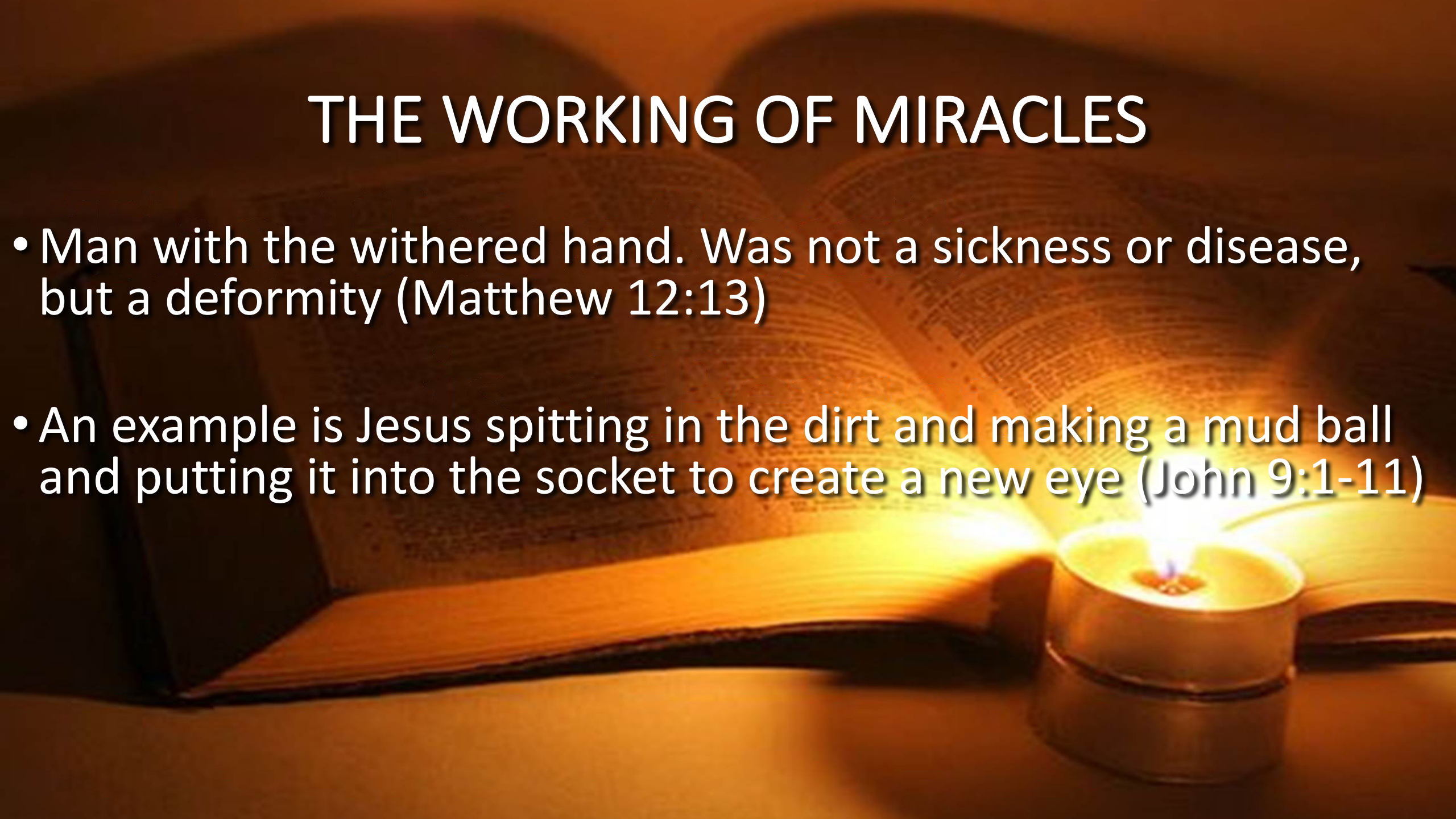
# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- Another miracle was the feeding of the 5000 men in John 6:5-14
- **Healing has to do with the eradication of sickness or disease**
- People who have a physical condition like something missing do not need healing, but a creative miracle
- The creation of something that was not there is a miracle, thus falls under the Gift of the Working of Miracles as opposed to the Gifts of Healings



# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- Man with the withered hand. Was not a sickness or disease, but a deformity (Matthew 12:13)
- An example is Jesus spitting in the dirt and making a mud ball and putting it into the socket to create a new eye (John 9:1-11)





# THE WORKING OF MIRACLES

- What are the conditions, the requirement, for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow?
  - **Must be born again**
  - **Must be Baptized in the Holy Spirit**
- The only other thing that Scripture says is:
  - **1 Corinthians 12:31, "But covet earnestly the best gifts..."**
