



- 2 Kings 1:10
- 10 But Elijah replied to the captain, "If I am a man of God, let fire come down from heaven and destroy you and your fifty men!" Then fire fell from heaven and killed them all.
- 12, "If I am a man of God, let fire come down from heaven and destroy you and your fifty men!" And again the fire of God fell from heaven and killed them all.

- Ten plagues against Egypt (Exodus 7-14)
- This Working of Miracles was used for a miraculous deliverance of God's people
- Speaking a word and the sun stands still is a miracle (Joshua 10:12-13)
- Causing an ax head to float is a miracle (II Kings 6:6)

- Another miracle was the feeding of the 5000 men in John 6:5 14
- Healing has to do with the eradication of sickness or disease
- People who have a physical condition like something missing do not need healing, but a creative miracle
- The creation of something that was not there is a miracle, thus falls under the Gift of the Working of Miracles as opposed to the Gifts of Healings

 Man with the withered hand. Was not a sickness or disease, but a deformity (Matthew 12:13)

• An example is Jesus spitting in the dirt and making a mud ball and putting it into the socket to create a new eye (John 9:1-11)

- What are the conditions, the requirement, for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow?
 - Must be born again
 - Must be Baptized in the Holy Spirit
- The only other thing that Scripture says is:
 - 1 Corinthians 12:31, "But covet earnestly the best gifts..."

- Gifts of Healings is the supernatural healing (of those who have disease or are infirmed) without the aid of natural or man-made means of any kind
- This means healings come as a result of no doctors, dry merbs, or other man-made intervention
- The Gifts of Healings is a supernatural manifestation of the power of God to heal & restore!

What is the purpose for the Gifts of Healings?

Is to deliver those who are sick and infirmed

To destroy the works of the devil in the human body

The Bible is full of such examples, especially NT!

 The Working of Miracles was more prominent in the Old Testament

The Gifts of Healings is more prominent in the New Testament

Jesus ministered under the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

- John 3:34
- 34 For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him.

• John 14:10-11

• 10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

 11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.
