THE GIFTS OF HEALING

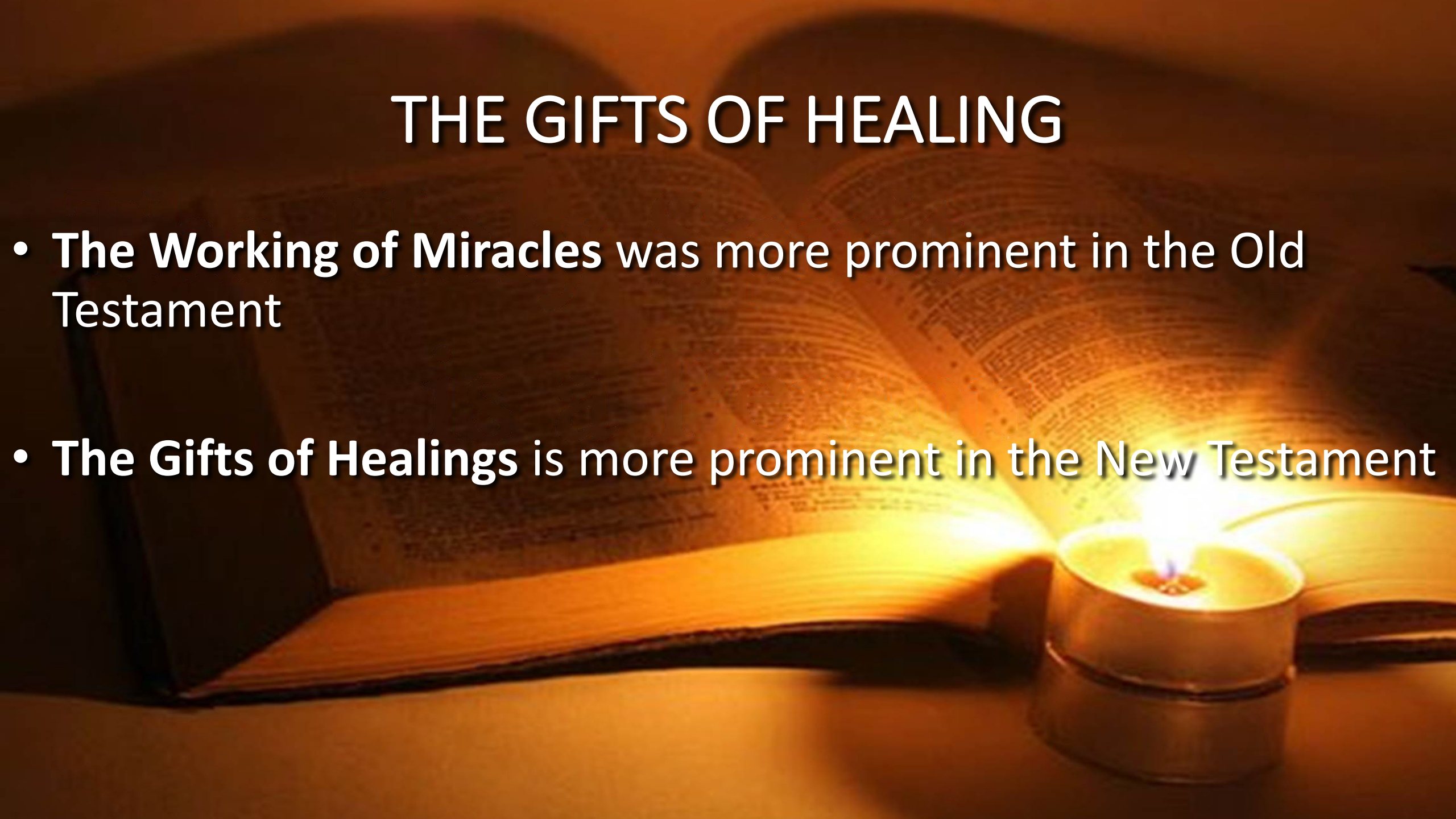
- *Gifts of Healings is the supernatural healing (of those who have disease or are infirmed) without the aid of natural or man-made means of any kind*
- This means healings come as a result of no doctors, drugs, herbs, or other man-made intervention
- The Gifts of Healings is a supernatural manifestation of the power of God to heal & restore!

THE GIFTS OF HEALING

- **What is the purpose for the Gifts of Healings?**
- **Is to deliver those who are sick and infirmed**
- **To destroy the works of the devil in the human body**
- **The Bible is full of such examples, especially NT!**

THE GIFTS OF HEALING

- **The Working of Miracles** was more prominent in the Old Testament
- **The Gifts of Healings** is more prominent in the New Testament



THE GIFTS OF HEALING

- Jesus ministered under the anointing of the Holy Spirit.
- John 3:34
- 34 For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: **for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him.**

THE GIFTS OF HEALING

- John 14:10-11
- 10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? **the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.**
- 11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or **else believe me for the very works' sake.**



THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

- Prophecy is the most important of the three gifts of inspiration, or utterance
- It takes the other two, divers kinds of tongues and the interpretation of tongues to equal prophecy
- I Cor. 14:5: “...greater is he that prophesieth than he that speaketh with tongues except he interpret”

THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

- Prophecy is the supernatural utterance in a known tongue (a language others can understand)
 - Divers kinds of tongues is supernatural utterance in an unknown tongue (language of the Spirit)
 - Interpretation of tongues is a supernatural showing forth of what has been said in tongues

THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

- The Hebrew word for “to prophecy” means “to flow forth”
- Also carries the thought “to bubble like a fountain”
- “To let drop, to lift up, to tumble forth, and to spring forth”
- The Greek word for prophecy means “to speak for another”

THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

- This means to speak for God or to be His spokesman
- I Cor 14:1 says to follow after love and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that we would prophesy
- This means to speak for God or to be His spokesman

THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

- This does not mean we should not desire the other gifts, but we should desire to prophesy
- The simple gift of prophecy should not be confused with the prophetic office
- Simple prophecy is speaking to men to edification, exhortation, and comfort (1 Cor. 14:3)

THE GIFT OF PROPHECY

- When the prophetic office is operating, there is often revelation given through prophecy.
- This means that the Revelation Gifts such as the Gift of the Word of Knowledge, The Gift of the Word of Wisdom or the Gift of Discernment of Spirits would be in operation.
