REVELATION GIFTS

- Let's review what we've learned so far:
- The Word of Knowledge is the supernatural gift where God reveals a piece (a fragment) of His knowledge to us
- The Word of Knowledge is always present or past tense
- This gift has nothing to do with natural human wisdom!
- The Word of Wisdom is the supernatural gift where God reveals a small piece of His plan or purpose
- This gift is always pointed at the future

THE DISCERNING OF SPIRITS

- The Discerning of Spirits gives insight into the spirit world
 - *This gift is not the discerning of devils or evil spirits*
- This gift has to do with spirits, both good and bad
- Supernatural insight into the realm of spirits
- Through this gift, believers not only may see angels but the Lord Jesus Himself & often converse with them too!

THE GIFT OF FAITH

The Gift of Faith as mentioned in some translations of the Bible in I Cor. 12:9 is rendered “special faith”

This makes this gift very different from other types of faith, such as saving faith (Romans 10:17)

Both types of faith are supernatural, but one is a higher level of faith, a “special manifestation of faith”

THE GIFT OF FAITH

- The Gift of Faith is very different from the fruit of faith listed in Galatians 5:22
- Galatians 5:22-23, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance...."
- In the original Greek, that fruit listed in the King James as "faith" is really the word "faithfulness"

THE GIFT OF FAITH

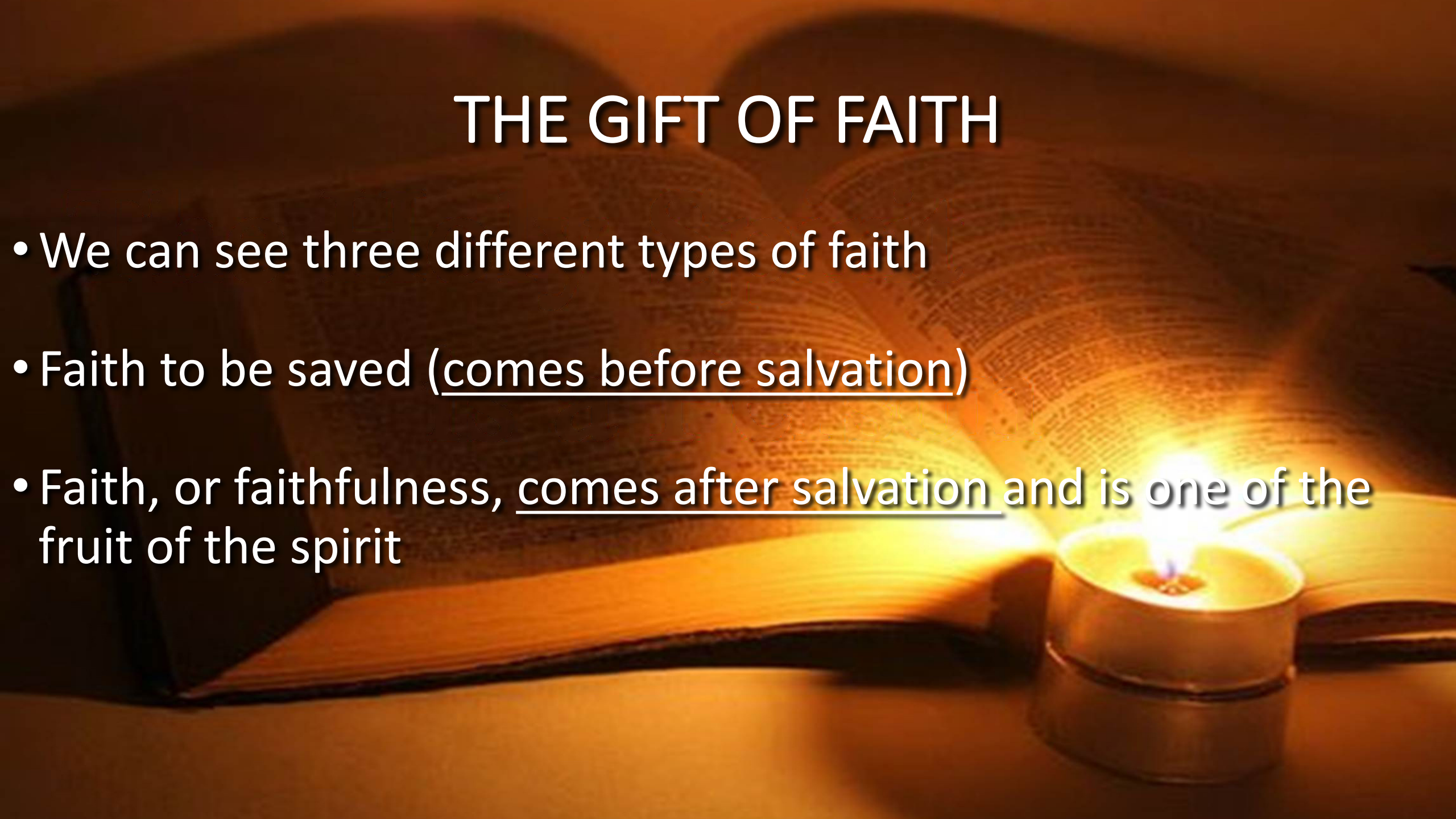
- The fruit of the spirit are for personal character
- The Gifts of the Spirit are for POWER
- Fruit is something that grows & develops
- Faithfulness is something that grows in a believer's life to establish them in spiritual character

THE GIFT OF FAITH

- The Gift of Faith, as recorded in I Corinthians 12, is a special kind of faith given by the Spirit of God
- This kind of faith does not grow
- Those who are gifted with this type of faith believe God in such a way that He honors their word just as though it was His own
- This Gift of Faith most often occurs in the midst of a crisis situation

THE GIFT OF FAITH

- We can see three different types of faith
- Faith to be saved (comes before salvation)
- Faith, or faithfulness, comes after salvation and is one of the fruit of the spirit

- The Gift of Faith comes after the Baptism of the Holy Spirit
- Taking God at His word and accepting what He says is not the Gift of Faith
- That “general” type of faith is one that grows as we meditate on God’s Word
- This is how we get answers to prayer

THE GIFT OF FAITH

- Mark 11:24 is referring to believing God's Word to get our prayers answered
