Objectives and Overview

The 3-Day Course (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) provides ABP diplomates seeking CDE credit for recertification, periodontists, general dentists, and other specialists with a comprehensive review and update. Many past participants in this course have attended it several times over the years because of its value to their practices. If you are facing a recertification examination, this course also helps meet your recertification CE requirements. The three days of comprehensive review and update cover:

- ✓ Current concepts – particularly as they relate to management of patients with advanced periodontal disease
- ✓ New developments and a general update in periodontics
- ✓ Systemic diseases' influences on periodontal disease, patient management, and periodontal medicine
- ✓ Management of office emergencies and diagnosis of oral lesions

The 5-Day Course is specifically designed to help periodontists prepare for the oral exam (Part II) for certification by the American Board of Periodontology. *This preparation is more important than ever*, given the apparent decrease in pass rates over the past few years and the fact that there is now only one oral exam given each year. The course begins with the three-day comprehensive review and update (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) followed by two days of mock oral board exams (Monday and Tuesday).

Each day of both courses begins at 8:00 AM and ends between 4:30 PM and 6:30 PM. The course ends at 6:30 PM on Tuesday, January 31, 2012.

2 Days of Mock Oral Board Exams

The 5-Day Course ends with two days of mock oral board exams. These mock exams simulate as closely as possible the real oral board exams. On the first day, each participant appears once before a pair of examiners. On the second day, each participant appears once before a different set of examiners.

When participants are not taking mock oral exams, they are encouraged to sit in the various exam rooms to observe others. This observation process is a key benefit of the overall mock oral board exam process. Periodontists who have passed the oral board exam report that the mock oral board process played a key role in improving their oral test-taking skills and boosting their self-confidence.
