INSPIRING A VIBRANT TOLEDO

Dear Friends of the Arts:

It is with much pride that The Arts Commission board and staff reflect back on 2014. The Arts Commission expresses its thanks to all the artists, talented trustees, skillful staff members and the caring citizens and volunteers of greater Toledo who have made it possible to do more at a time when all the economic indicators say we should have been cutting services, not building new and stronger programs.

RESPONSIBILITY TO CITY

During this time The Arts Commission fulfilled its charge from the City of Toledo to administer the 1% for Arts program. The third phase of Artist Designed Bike Racks were installed throughout the city, while the second phase of the Toledo Poetry Sidewalks Project was installed along Collingwood Blvd. Conservation efforts saw revitalization of The Flame in East Toledo, and several new projects for 2015 were launched, including the I-280 Mural and Anthony Wayne Trail Gateway Project.

ADVOCACY

The Arts Commission coordinated arts advocacy efforts locally, with Board members and staff visiting legislators and participating in Arts Day in Columbus. Executive Director Marc Folk has represented Toledo and Northwest Ohio in Columbus as a member of the Board of the Ohio Citizens for the Arts and across the country as a participant in Americans for the Arts. Marc was also one of a handful of arts leaders selected to participate in Americans for the Arts Leadership Institute at Sundance.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

The Arts Commission continued community meeting efforts to complete the City of Toledo's Strategic Plan for Arts and Culture, focusing input from the Downtown area's eight original neighborhoods. This became the final year for the SoundTrek program, it's most successful to date, with plans to hand the program over to neighborhood leaders in UpTown and the Village on Adams.

YOUTH ENGAGEMENT

The Young Artists at Work (YAAW) program celebrated its 20th anniversary this year with several special projects, including the near four-story "Building Momentum" mural on the Parkwood Building, which went on to be formally included in the Toledo Museum of Art's permanent collection. YAAW engaged 50 apprentices, aged 14-18, from 30 high schools.

The Ninth Congressional District Invitational Art Exhibition celebrated it's 21st year, featuring 60 artworks from 11 schools. For the first time, as the district's boundaries expanded, a second exhibition was held on the campus at Baldwin Wallace University near west Cleveland.

FUNDING

The Arts Commission Board and staff successfully reached out to friends, corporations, foundations and other funding sources, producing a balanced budget in one of the toughest fundraising years in our history. Toledo artist Edith Franklin added a second endowment fund to support Arts Commission programs at the Toledo Community Foundation, establishing a fund to support youth arts programming. The Arts Commission also has been successful in partnering with other organizations to expand our precious, limited resources.

LIVE WORK CREATE TOLEDO

ART WALKS

The Art Walk series celebrate a successful seventh season in 2014. On the fourth Thursday of each month, May through September, several hundred guests came out to enjoy and purchase the work of more than 100 local, national and international artists. On average, the monthly series featured 25 to 30 partnering galleries, studios, and local businesses. During the months of May and June, guided walking tours with Arts Commission staff and volunteers were offered to guests as an easy and fun way to explore new or perhaps less visible venues participating in the event. The 20th Anniversary of the Arts Commission's Young Artists At Work (YAAW) program was highlighted during the July event.

ART LOOPS

One Gallery Loop in April and another Holiday Loop in November provided convenient transportation for guests with four buses traveling two loops visiting over 30 partnering venues in and around Downtown. Over 1,000 guests attended each event, experiencing the work of more than 150 participating artists.

ARTOMATIC 419!

Planning for the spring 2015 Artomatic 419! was underway throughout 2014. Local artists and volunteers met in sub-committee meetings on a regular basis to design and prepare for Northwest Ohio's largest non-juried arts showcase for the visual, literary and performing arts.

SOUNDTREK

2014 would be the final year for The Arts Commission hosting the SoundTrek Local Music Festival, with plans to hand the program over to organizers in the UpTown and Village on Adams neighborhoods. The event hosted 33 local and regional bands and saw 127 individual artists paid to perform during the night. More than 1,500 guests came out to enjoy live music on Adams Street throughout the evening.

ARTIST DESIGNED BIKE RACKS - DOWNTOWN AND SURROUNDING AREAS

2014 saw the continuation of the Artist Designed Bike Racks project with ten new bike racks installed in and surrounding the Downtown Toledo area. A public reception to celebrate the artists and the installation of the second phase of this ongoing project took place on Wednesday, July 2nd, 5:30pm at the Black Kite Coffee Shop in The Old West End. \$22,500

POETRY SIDEWALKS - COLLINGWOOD BOULEVARD

In the second phase of the project saw ten poems selected from a total of 81 submissions received from 51 local poets. Installation occurred in conjunction with sidewalk replacement during the Collingwood resurfacing project in mid-October 2014. This project intends to compliment recent renovations along Collingwood Blvd, including that of Scott High School, repaving of streets and sidewalks, streetscape enhancements, and the forthcoming installation of a new public art work. \$9,240

UNDERWAY - PROJECTS LAUNCHED IN 2014

I-280 MURAL RFQ

A request for qualifications was launched in February of 2014 for a large-scale mural on the City of Toledo's Park Maintenance facility adjacent to I-280.

AWT GATEWAY RFQ

A request for qualifications was launched in February for infrastructure enhancements for a major roadway redesign project in conjunction with the Ohio Department of Transportation and the City of Toledo.

CONSERVATION

The Flame – This sculpture underwent a thorough cleaning to remove graffiti and debris from the base. An assessment was made this year to identify needs for 2015 and beyond including works needed on the General Steedman monument and painting needs. \$2,191



YOUTH SERVICES

YOUNG ARTISTS AT WORK

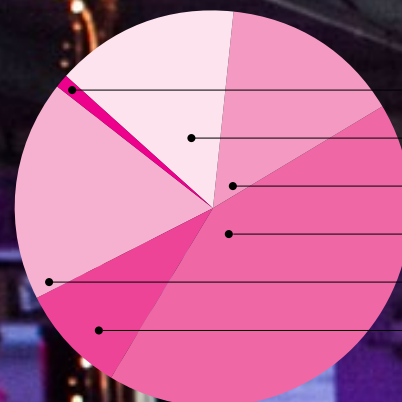
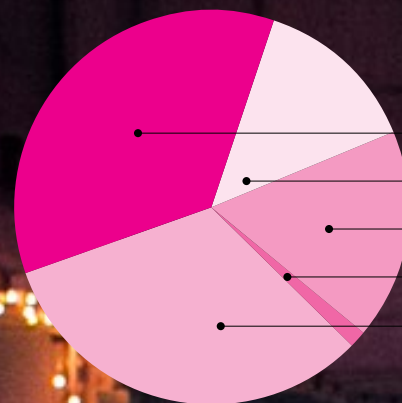
In its 20th year, YAAW engaged 50 apprentices, ages 14-18 from 30 high schools, for an intensive, six-week employment experience in the arts focused on job skill development. Young artists muraled 15 park benches installed in neighbors surrounding downtown Toledo that were active collaborators in the creation of the City of Toledo's Strategic Plan for Arts and Culture. The apprentices painted a 3.5-story mural on the side of the Professional Building housing The Arts Commission offices, titled Building Momentum. The apprentices performed the original theatrical work titled Throw your Paint in the world-class Toledo Museum of Art Peristyle theatre. In addition to this summer's program, the 20th Anniversary of the YAAW program was also celebrated through the creation of the Building Momentum mural, hosting of a first ever YAAW alum exhibition in the Secor Gallery in downtown Toledo, additional marketing for the program with a 20th Anniversary brochure, other YAAW alumni networking events and being a focused highlight during the July Art Walk event.

CONGRESSIONAL

The Arts Commission celebrates the talents of artists in our regional high schools in the Ninth Congressional District Invitational Art Exhibition. Last year, more than 60 artworks were submitted representing 11 high schools in the competition. Twenty-four artworks received awards. For a ninth year, Libbey Glass presented a unique award, selecting one student design to be featured on a limited run of glassware. The exhibition displayed inside Fifth Third Center at One Seagate. This year, the show traveled for the first time to show for a second time on the campus of Baldwin Wallace University, a new partner in the eastern part of the district, joining our organization to celebrate the talent of our local young artists.

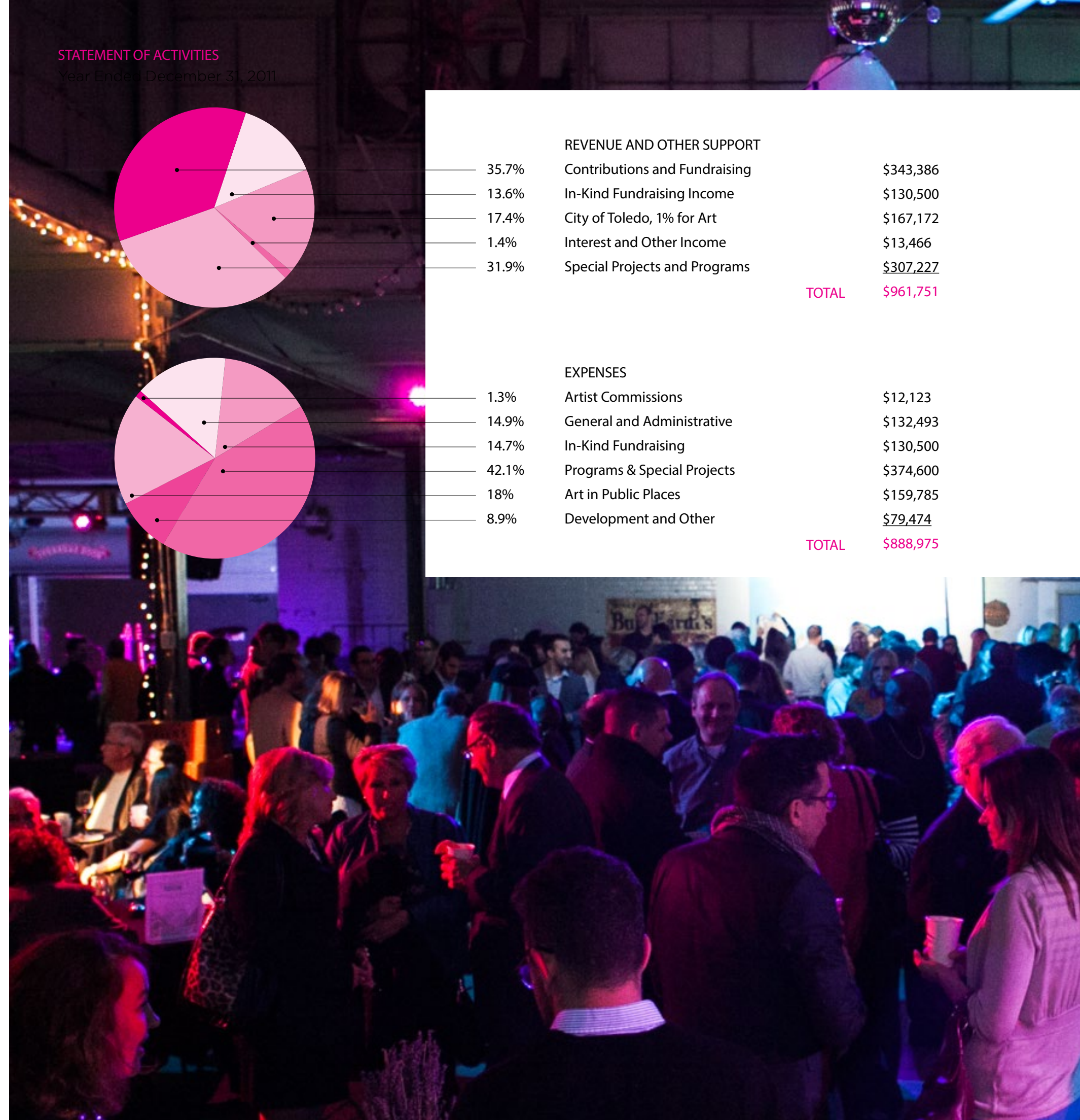

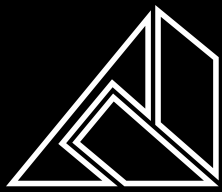
