STREET VENDING ARTISTS

MUST Have a Transient Vendor's Licence

For artists who are interested in selling goods at various shows and markets throughout the state of Ohio you will need to obtain a Transient Vendor's License for the legal collection of state sales tax. The State offers licenses for an initial fee of \$25. Once you've applied for your TVL you will need to set up an Ohio Business Gateway account, where you can find details on how to report and pay sales tax.
