2020 Young Artists At Work Apprentices Job Description (Applicants, be sure to share this information with your parent/legal guardian.)

Young Artists At Work (YAAW) is an ART (primarily visual art) employment opportunity for youth ages 14–18. If employed, apprentices will be paid minimum wage (\$8.70 per hour) and work 30 hours per week:

Daily Monday – Friday

From 9:00am – 4:00pm with a one hour unpaid lunch.

For six weeks Monday, June 29th – Friday, August 7th, 2020

YAAW will NOT be in session on Thursday, July 4th, 2020 in observance of Independence Day.

Apprentices will not receive holiday pay.

Missing more than three days of work is cause for termination. If an applicant has other summer engagements (family vacations, football, band camp, etc.) that will require missing more than three days, he or she will be required to choose between YAAW employment and the other engagement.

The position as a YAAW apprentice is a paid job. As good employees, all apprentices will be expected to arrive on time, be productive, be respectful of art staff and fellow apprentices, follow directions and dress appropriately

If employed, you **will be assigned** to work on a variety of VISUAL art projects either in groups or individually. These projects may include but are not limited to: painting a community mural, sketching/drawing and creating saleable works of art in the form of ceramics, bronze casting, photography, printmaking, and sculpture. You may also be asked to perform in a play, write poetry, or design and update websites, brochures, and posters for the YAAW program,

All three sections of the application (applicant contact info and data; parent and legal guardian data; and character recommendation) must be received in order for the applicant to be considered for employment.

The status of your application will be communicated to you by a letter sent via the U.S. mail. If you have an address change, please call our office ASAP to update your application information. All applicants will be sent a letter by April 20th confirming application status. Please call our offices at (419) 254-2787 if you do not receive a letter from us by this date.

All candidates will be asked to bring in a portfolio or samples of their VISUAL artwork if scheduled for an in-person interview. We suggest bringing in 3-5 samples of your best VISUAL artwork, which may include digital imaging. You will also be asked to select another visual image that is not your own, but that still inspires you. You will bring this image to your interview to discuss why it inspires you with the interviewer.
