The Alzheimer's Association sets up tents for star fundraising teams, which are teams that raise more than ten thousand dollars for the walk. For the 2017 walk, Theta Omicron raised \$16,095 for the walk this year and ranked 15<sup>th</sup> nationally across Sigma Kappa teams.

Across all Sigma Kappa teams nationally, \$1,112,133 has been raised for the Alzheimer's Association in the past year thus far. We at Theta Omicron hope to continue our legacy of being the top fundraising team at the Phoenix walk, and next year, we want to be the top Sigma Kappa team in the nation!
