A new fiscal year is upon us (starting July 1st, 2023)! Thank you so much to all of our amazing supporters who paid their dues in the past fiscal year, we couldn't have a chapter without you.

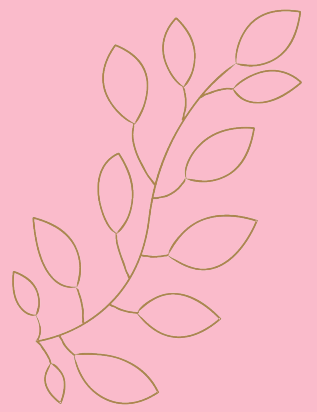
DG Beach Day

Recruitment Prep

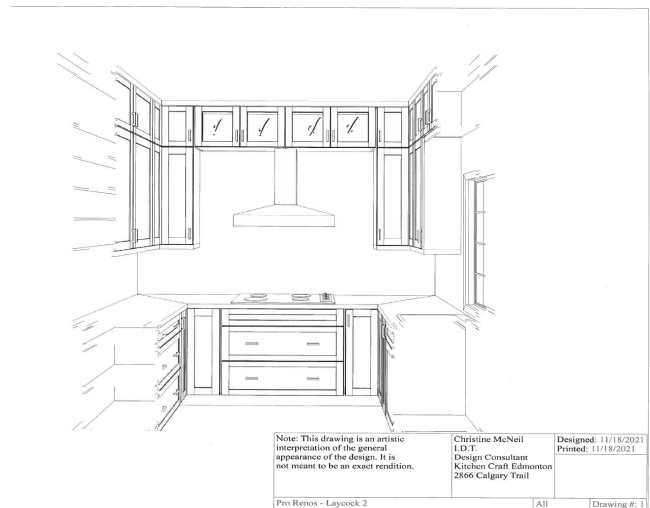

House Corporation Update



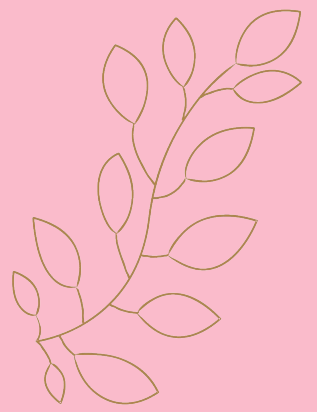

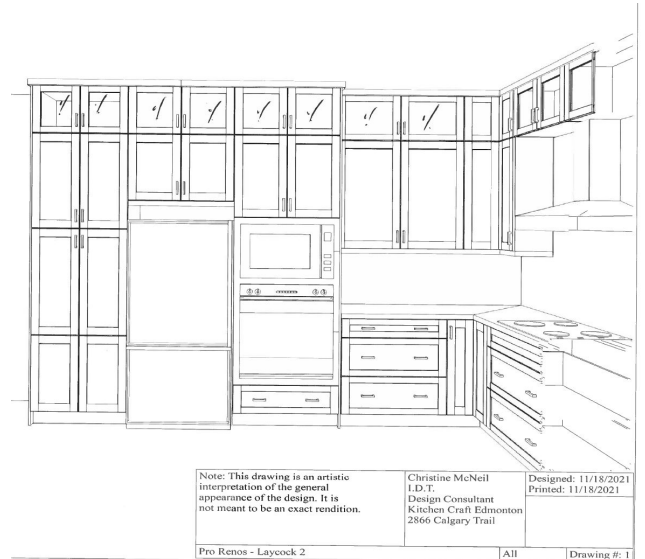
