

SERVICE PROJECT WITH HOUSTON AREA WOMEN'S CENTER

For our Service Project, HAA will be supporting the **Houston Area Women's Center** to support women and children who are domestic violence victims. HAWC is a multi-racial, multi-lingual agency that supports survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and sex trafficking. They provide immediate access to 24/7 crisis intervention services, ongoing trauma-informed support programs, and violence prevention initiatives to survivors, their

support networks, and communities. Since 1977, they have empowered hundreds of thousands of victims of violence to transform into survivors and establish self-determined lives. HAWC provides Crisis Response with 24/7 hotlines, emergency shelter, and rape crisis support. They also engage in survivor empowerment including counseling, legal advocacy, housing, financial empowerment, and children's services. Additionally, HAWC works with the community to break the cycle of domestic violence by providing education and awareness.

There are 3 ways to donate:

- 2. In-Person Donations: Items can be brought to any Day & Night Gatherings in November, and I will coordinate with those hosts to pick up the items and deliver them to HAWC. Items that are needed include the following (all items must be new/unopened):
- shampoo bar soap deodorant toothpaste toothbrushes body wash conditioner razors combs/hair brushes women's sanitary products sports bras PJ pant sets
