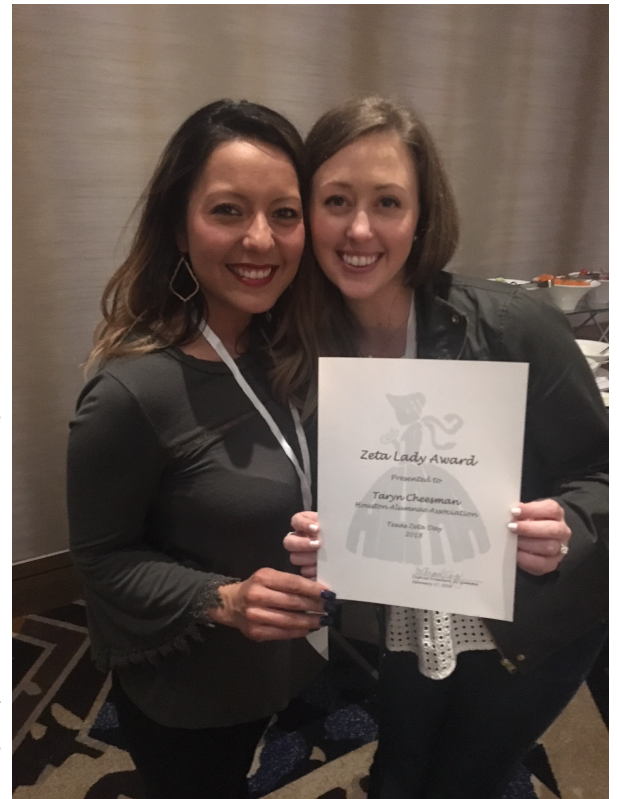




Leslie Hix received her White Violet pin and was pinned by her pledge sister (who also receiving her White Violet pin). What a special Gamma Tau sister moment!

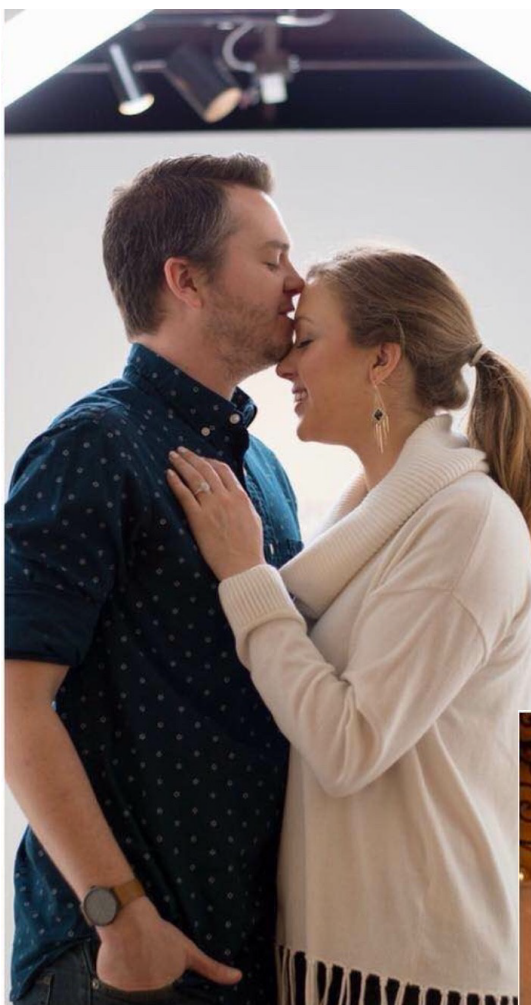
Carolyn Moore passed away on February 3rd, 2018. Please keep her family, sisters and friends in your prayers.

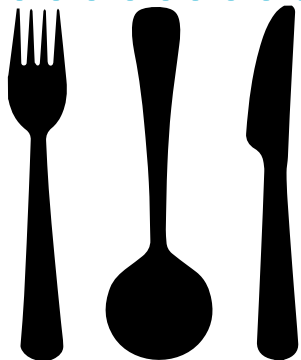
