


November

Last April, we were fortunate to send our own, **Melissa Turnbull Runkvist** on a Hope Serving trip to St. Louis! It was there that she volunteered at the Delta Gamma Center, aiding in their annual Celebration for Sight event.

When asked to share some highlights from her trip, she responded with:

It was inspiring to see how the Center supports children with vision loss. One highlight was learning about their tandem bike program, which pairs children with vision loss and sighted volunteers so they can ride together. Each bike is customized to meet the child's individual needs, as many children live with multiple disabilities in addition to vision loss.

During Celebration for Sight, we helped set up and run activities for children and their families. It was heartwarming to see the joy and connection this event creates, helping kids just be kids!



I'm so grateful for this experience and for the chance to see firsthand the impact of Delta Gamma's philanthropy. I also loved meeting sisters from other chapters and exploring St. Louis together.

Hope Serving trips happen several times a year, and I encourage everyone to apply. The experience is unforgettable and deeply rewarding!




